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INTRODUCTORY NOTE.

The Census, the statistics of which are embodied in this Volume, was taken on 26th February, 1931.

A few of the Tables prescribed this time by the Government of India, were omitted by the Provincial Census Office for the Province of Rajputana and Ajmer-Merwara and later on some more Tables were cancelled by the Government of India itself as a measure of economy. All the Tables so omitted are mentioned below :—

- (1) Infirmities by Selected Castes, Tribes or Races.
- (2) Subsidiary Occupations of Agriculturists.
- (3) Table showing for certain mixed occupations the number of persons, who returned each occupation as their (a) principal and (b) subsidiary means of livelihood.
- (4) Organized Industry.
- (5) Distribution by Religion in different occupations.
- (6) Summary Figures for Districts.

Economy was also effected by curtailing Statistical output in some Tables. Thus in the case of Table VI instructions were received not to prepare Statistics of internal migration between one District or State and another District or State but only of external migration by Provinces. Particulars regarding Sects and Race of Christian population were also required to be given in the form of additional details to Table XVI instead of in a separate Table. Regarding Table XI, only Part A was required to be prepared and that also for Europeans and Anglo-Indians only.

Table XII regarding "Educated Unemployment" has also not been prepared as instructions were to collect statistics of unemployment only in respect of such persons as may have at least matriculated and as only one solitary instance of unemployment in the light of this standard came under notice in the Town of Rajaldebar.

In addition to the Imperial Tables prescribed by the Government of India, four Provincial Tables have been compiled instead of two as usual, the two additional Tables prepared, namely Nos. III and IV, relating to the Distribution of Selected Castes in the Administrative Units of the State, and the Distribution of population therein by Languages commonly spoken in Rajputana and Ajmer-Merwara.

Over and above the Imperial and Provincial Tables, two special State Tables have been compiled this time. Table I shows Literacy in the Urban area. The compilation of this Table was necessitated by the fact that towns as separate Administrative Units were this time required by the Provincial census office to be omitted from the Provincial Tables. Table II shows Industrial Statistics for the State. This Table was compiled as a result of the special Economic Census undertaken this time.

* NOTE.—The statistics, are however available regarding this in Imperial Table XVI and Provincial Table I.

Area, Houses and Population.

Explanatory Note.

An increase of 2 square miles over the area of the State in 1921 is explained by the transfer of a portion of the village *Gumjal* from the Punjab during the last decade.

It may be noted here that the area of the State mentioned in the Provincial Census Report, 1881 (22,340 square miles) and in the Provincial Census Report, 1891 (23,173 square miles) is incorrect and the error was rectified in 1901 after recalculation in the Surveyor-General's Office by planimeter from the Standard Topographical Sheets. The correct area entered in 1901 Provincial Census Report is 23,311 square miles. In the Report for 1911, the area of the State mentioned is 23,315 square miles, the increase being due to the transfer of the 2 villages of *Ratakheda* and *Babalwas* from the Punjab.

The areas of the Bikaner and Surpura Tehsils have been adjusted to changes made in their boundaries since 1921 and the areas of the Bikaner Nizamat and Tehsil have been rectified also in the light of the actual area included in the Bikaner City and its Suburbs.

The area of the Suratgarh Nizamat has been reduced to the extent of the area of a new Nizamat formed out of it, namely, Sri Ganganagar Nizamat.

Explanatory Note.

In the State Report for 1921, the figures of population for Nizamats and Tehsils for the three Censuses of 1881, 1891 and 1901 have not been mentioned as being not available. These figures were, however, very kindly supplied by the Provincial Census Superintendent. The figures obtained from him were further verified from the State Census records and the Report of 1891. Even then these figures could not be of much use for comparison, as the boundaries of Nizamats and Tehsils at the time of the three Censuses in question were found to be different from what they are now. Accordingly the population of the Nizamats and Tehsils for 1891 and 1901 was adjusted to their present boundaries after ascertaining the old boundaries from the past Records of the State. The population of the Nizamats and Tehsils for 1881 could not be adjusted not only because no information is available of the boundaries of the Nizamats and Tehsils at the time, but also because as stated in the State Census Report for 1891, and as also intimated by the Provincial Census Superintendent, the figures of population of the various Nizamats and Tehsils in 1881, when added up, do not tally with the total population returned for the whole State in 1881. As mentioned in the State Census Report for 1891, this is due to the population of 5 *Chiras* (as they were then called) being unaccounted for.

The population of 1921 has also been adjusted to changes effected in the boundaries of the Nizamats and Tehsils between 1921-31; and the figures of population for the newly-formed Ganganagar Nizamat and its Tehsils, as they would have been in 1921 in case they then existed as separate units, have also been worked out to show the increase of population in the Canal area.

It may just be mentioned that the total population of the State for 1881, 1891, and 1901 as mentioned in the Provincial Census Reports for those years do not tally with the total population for those Censuses as mentioned in the Provincial Census Reports for 1911 and 1921 owing to the population of the past Censuses having been adjusted in consequence of the transfer of the villages of *Ratakhera* and *Babalwas* from the Punjab between 1901 and 1911. No such adjustment was necessary owing to the transfer of a portion of the village *Gumjal* from the Punjab between 1921 and 1931, inasmuch as the area so transferred was an uninhabited one.

Explanatory Note.

Sri Ganganagar and Hanumangarh have been included as Towns for the first time in this Census. The population of these places in all the past Censuses as also that of Bhadra and Dungergarh, not mentioned in the 1921 State Census Report, has been ascertained from the Census Records and entered in this Table.

Towns have been mentioned in order of population and arranged in 4 classes (I) 20,000 and over, (II) 10,000-20,000, (III) 5,000-10,000 and (IV) under 5,000.-

Unlike Table III, in this Table Travellers by Railway are included in the population of the Towns, in whose limits they were enumerated. This has not, however, affected the classification of any Town as compared with that in Table III.

The population of the Bikaner City returned at the 1881 and 1891 Censuses as stated in the Provincial Census Reports of these Censuses is respectively 43,283 and 56,252. These figures, however, do not tally with the population of the City for those Censuses as mentioned in all the subsequent Provincial Census Reports of 1901, 1911 and 1921. The difference cannot be accounted for. In the present Table the population of the City for 1881 and 1891 has been taken from the latest Provincial Census Report of 1921 as advised by the Provincial Census Superintendent.

Explanatory Note.

This Table corresponds to the old Table XI and shows the Birth-places of persons enumerated in the State and City. Under instructions from the Provincial Census Office, figures were not compiled this time by Districts and States in which the foreign-born persons were born but only by Provinces. The Table accordingly shows particulars in the case of foreign-born persons only by Provinces and not by Districts and States.

Figures were compiled in the last Census for the whole State. This time the Table has been compiled by Nizamats also in order to ascertain the proportion of immigration in different parts of the State.

Explanatory Note.

This Table is divided into three parts, each showing the distribution of population by age, sex and civil condition.

Part I.—Shows for the State as a whole the distribution of the total population (all religions) and of each religion.

Part II.—Shows the distribution of population of each religion.

Part III —Shows for the City the distribution of the total population (all religions).

In Parts II and III, the age periods are given in less details than in Part I, those for the individual years 1, 2, 3 and 4 being compressed into one period 1-5 and those from 20 onwards being compressed into 5 periods 20-30, 30-40, 40-50, 50-60 and 60 and over.

The ages of the people recorded in the Census Schedules represent the number of years to nearest birth-day or the nearest age in years known. Divorced persons have been included in the heading "Widowed" provided that they were not re-married.

The term 'Hindus' in this Table includes Arya, Brahmo and Deo-Samajists.

Explanatory Note.

This Table corresponds to old Table XVII and shows the occupations which were returned in the Schedules as the principal or subsidiary means of livelihood or as the occupations of working dependants.

Separate figures are given for the City. The persons following different occupations were distinguished in 1921 only in two classes, namely, (1) Actual Workers and (2) Dependents. Subsidiary occupations were compiled but only in relation to Agriculture. The distinction made in the present Census, on the other hand, classifies all persons into (1) Earners (2) Working Dependents (3) Non-working Dependents and (4) those following an occupation as a subsidiary one (in addition to their principal occupation).

The method of classifying occupations followed in the Census of 1921 has been retained with slight modifications. Thus the number of Classes and Sub-Classes remain the same. The number of Orders, however, has been reduced from 56 to 55 owing to the reclassification under Sub-Class II into (1) Metallic Minerals and (2) Non-metallic Minerals instead of into (1) Mines, (2) Quarries of hard rocks and (3) Salt etc. in 1921. The Groups within the orders have been changed considerably. The Appendix to this Table shows how the Groups of 1921 compare with those of the present Census.

The Orders and Groups, under which no occupations were returned, have been omitted from the Table.

Explanatory Note.

This Table corresponds to the old Table XIII and shows the castes in an alphabetical order by sex and religion. In all 158 castes were returned this time in the State as against 155 including 63 castes included under the head "Minor Castes" in 1921. The difference is negligible. This time all the castes have been shown in the Table, and the minor castes have not been thrown together.

Entries in the Schedules, which were synonyms or were local equivalents of a caste, have been amalgamated with the castes to which they appeared to belong in the light of the list supplied by the Provincial Census Office or of inquiries locally made. Such synonyms and equivalents have been entered in the remarks column against the caste concerned.

This time the main castes under *Brahmans* have also been given in the Table. Figures for the main clans of Rajputs and the sub-clans of Rathors and Kachhwahas have been given in the Appendix at the end of this Table.

Explanatory Note.

The four Provincial Tables in this Volume give statistics for the Administrative Units in the State. The last two of these Tables are new.

In the 1921 Census, the City and Towns were also adopted as separate Units. This time under instructions from the Provincial Census Office, the Towns have been omitted from all the Provincial Tables. Such information, however, about Towns as was available in 1921 Provincial Tables, is contained in Imperial Tables IV and V except about Literacy. Statistics about literacy for Towns have accordingly been specially compiled and incorporated in a separate Table (*vide* State Table I appended at the end of this Volume).

This Table (Provincial Table I) shows for each Unit, its area, number of towns, villages and of houses in the urban and rural areas, population both rural and urban, density of population per square mile, population of 1921 and percentage of variations for 1911-1921 and 1921-1931. The boundaries of the Units having been changed, the population of 1921 has been entered in column 14 after adjusting it to present area and the percentages in columns 15 and 16 have also been calculated on adjusted population. The figures in these columns will not, therefore, agree with those of the previous Censuses.
