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INTRODUCTION

The history of District Census Handbooks dates back to 1951 when they were first introduced in almost all the States of India. In the case of Jammu and Kashmir State, however, the handbooks were published for the first time at the 1961 Census. There was no Census in the State in 1951 due to the disturbed conditions prevailing in the wake of Pakistani invasion in 1947-48. The District Census Handbooks of 1961 Census had been designed to present a uniform frame throughout the country and contained exhaustive census and non-census data, supplemented by an appraisal of socio-economic development of the district.

At 1971 Census, however, efforts have been made to further diversify the content and scope of the handbooks. For the first time village and town directory data which give diverse type of basic amenities as available in each village and town of the district was compiled to be incorporated in the handbooks in order to cater to the requirements of various government and semi-government agencies in such methods as adjustment of administrative boundaries; educational planning; man-power planning etc. In order that the data was promptly released soon after its compilation, the District Census Handbooks were divided into the following convenient parts so that atleast parts A & B, which contained the essential data down to village and ward of a town, were released quickly :—

- Part A i) Town Directory, and
 ii) Village Directory
- Part B i) Urban Block and Village-wise
 Primary Census Abstract
- Part C i) Analytical Report,
 ii) Administrative Statistics, and
 iii) Census tables

The parts A & B of the District Census Handbooks, the details of which were simultaneously made ready have been clubbed in one volume and have since been published for the districts of the State.

Part C of the volume was originally designed to consist of administrative, welfare and developmental statistics and census tables supplemented by a comprehensive analytical report aimed at bringing

out socio-economic and demographic changes which have in particular come about in the district during 1961-71. As the administrative, welfare and developmental statistics was not uniformly available for all the districts of the State, its inclusion in this volume has been dropped. Also analytical report and testing of various hypotheses have altogether been taken out of the purview of this publication and instead the data has been presented in two parts each preceded by a brief fly-leaf. Set A gives census tables based on 1971 Census and set B tables on village directory data and primary census abstract generated on the computer.

The following definitions on the basis of which census tables have been compiled will prove useful for appreciating the contents of these tables :—

Village

A Census village is ordinarily the same thing as revenue mauza, but in some cases differs therefrom. It may contain one or many groups of houses or hamlets or on the other hand contain no houses at all. The following definition has been adopted at the 1971 Census.

Every village with well defined boundaries for revenue assessment having residential houses densely or sparsely populated was treated as a village irrespective of the number of hamlets of which it was constituted.

Town

The definition of urban as adopted at the 1971 Census, is as follows :—

- a) all places with a Municipality, Corporation or Cantonment or Notified/Town area ;
- b) all other places which satisfied the following criteria :—
 - i) a minimum population of 5,000 ;
 - ii) atleast 75 percent of male working population is non-agriculturists ; and
 - iii) a density of population of 400 per Km² (i.e. 1,000 per Sq. mile).

Census House

A Census house is a building or part of a building having a separate main entrance from the road or common courtyard or staircase etc. used or recognised as a separate unit. It may be inhabited

or vacant. It may be used for a residential or non-residential purpose or both.

Household

A household is defined as the entire group of persons who commonly live together and take their meals from a common mess unless the exigencies of work prevent them from doing so. A household can be either a one person household i.e, a person who makes provision for his own food or other essentials for living without combining with any other person to form part of a multiperson household. It may be a multiperson household i.e, a group of two or more persons who make common provision for food or other essentials for living. They may be related or unrelated persons or a combination of both.

Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes

The definition of Scheduled Castes as laid down in article 49 (1) of the State Constitution is reproduced below :

“Scheduled Castes mean the castes, races or tribes or part of or groups within castes, races or tribes which are for the purposes of Constitution of India, deemed to be Scheduled Castes in relation to the State under the Provision of Article 341 of that Constitution.”

There are no Scheduled Tribes in Jammu and Kashmir. So far as Scheduled Caste are concerned the following castes have been deemed to be Scheduled Castes for Jammu and Kashmir according to the Scheduled Castes Order of 1956 issued by the President in pursuance of the provisions of Article 341 of the Constitution of India :—

1. Barwala,
2. Basith,
3. Batwal,
4. Chamar or Ramdasia,
5. Chura,
6. Dhyar,
7. Doom or Mahasha,
8. Gardi,
9. Jolaha,
10. Megh or Kabirpanthi,
11. Ratal,
12. Saryara, and
13. Watal.

Literacy & Education

The test of literacy for the 1971 Census was

satisfied if a person above the age of four could with understanding both read and write.

An educated person is one who has passed a written examination of a recognised educational standard.

Worker and Non-worker

A worker was a person whose main activity was participation in any economically productive work by his physical or mental activity. Work involved not only actual work but effective supervision or direction of work.

A worker was one whose main activity was in any of the following nine categories :—

- I. Cultivation,
- II. Agricultural labour,
- III. Livestock, Forestry, Fishing, Hunting and Plantations, Orchards and Allied Activities,
- IV. Mining and Quarrying,
- V(a) Household Industry,
- V(b) Manufacturing other than Household Industry,
- VI. Construction,
- VII. Trade & Commerce,
- VIII. Transport, Storage & Communications, and
- IX. Other services.

A non-worker was a person who was not engaged in any economically productive activity. Non-workers were divided into the following seven categories :—

- i) In household duties,
- ii) Student,
- iii) A retired person or rentire or royalty receiver,
- iv) Dependents, such as infant or disabled or very old person,
- v) Beggar or vagrant,
- vi) Inmates of penal and charitable institution, and
- vii) Others made up of mostly un-employed.

TABLES ON CENSUS DATA

FLY-LEAF TO SET A TABLES

This section covers 42 tables based on the 1971 Census data. These tables give census information down to tehsil and town of the district highlighting socio-economic, demographic and cultural profile of the district. The compilation of census tables are apportioned into six sets known as A-General Population tables, B-Economic tables, C-Social and Cultural tables, D-Migration tables, E-Establishment tables and H-Housing tables.

A-series tables give information on area; houses and population; jurisdiction; distribution of villages by size class of population; houseless and institutional population and villages and towns of the district classified by population.

B-series tables provide data on workers and non-workers classed by sex and broad age-groups; industrial classification of workers and non-workers by educational levels in urban areas only; industrial classification of persons at work other than at cultivation as main activity by sex divisions, major groups and minor groups and classification of workers in manufacturing, processing, servicing and repairs on household industry basis as main activity by sex and class of workers.

C-series tables highlight information on age and marital status; age, sex and education in all areas and urban areas; mother tongue; religion and classification by literacy and industrial category of workers and non-workers among scheduled castes.

D-series tables depict population classified by place of birth; migrants to urban units with a

population of 1,00,000 persons and above classified by sex, broad age-groups, educational levels and in case of workers by occupational divisions, migrant workers and non-workers according to main activity and migrants classified by place of last residence, age-groups, duration of residence and marital status.

E-series tables indicate establishments by broad types; manufacturing, processing or servicing establishments other than household industries classified by registered factories, unregistered workshops and size of employment; manufacturing, processing or servicing establishments other than household industries classified by industry, fuel/power or manual used and size of employment; trade/commercial establishments classified by type of business or trade and size of employment and establishments (other than manufacturing, processing, servicing or business and trade establishments) by size of employment.

H-series tables portray information on census houses and the use to which they are put; distribution of census houses by predominant material of wall and roof; households classified by number of members and by number of rooms occupied.

In addition there are five special tables pertaining to Scheduled Caste population only which give Industrial Classification of persons at work and non-workers by sex for rural and urban; age and marital status; education in rural and urban areas; and persons not at work classified by sex, type of activity and educational levels.
