


The motif represents an Ao Naga Youth in his traditional attire used generally on ceremonial occasions. The most spectacular features of their dresses as seen in the motif are, (a) The headgear, which has a round black base — 'Temko' — made of bear's hairs, on which is fixed feathers of Hornbill — 'Ozumi' — the number of which is determined by the status of the man in the society, (b) a short necklace — 'Shipu' — made of wild boar tush, (c) a comparatively longer necklace — 'Shiretzuk' — made of shell and glass beads, (d) a Sash — 'Sokumangitsu' — with diamond designs in red colour and dyed goat's hair hanging from one side, which is a symbolic representation of one's victims hair (e) Ivory armband — 'Kumpang' — (f) the Spear decorated with dyed goat's hair and the tail feathers of a bird called Racket-tailed Drongo — 'Yimyu' (Yimyi) — used as ear ornament.

P R E F A C E

The District Census Hand Books are a new set of sources of information as far as Nagaland is concerned even though the innovation was first introduced in the 1951 Census. This book will serve as a valuable source of information to the planners, administrators, legislators and other public bodies.

It was originally decided to bring out the D. C. H. of each District in three volumes namely, Part-A, Part-B and Part-C separately. But, since the data for Part A & B have been compiled at the same time for this district, it has been decided to combine Part-A and Part-B into one volume. The Part - A portion furnishes the information about the rural areas in the "village directory" and about the urban areas in the "town directory" which has been explained elaborately in the Introductory Notes On District Census Hand Book. The data collected by the enumerators for the village directories are crude in nature and I am fully conscious and aware of the limitations of the data. The Part-B portion being a vital part of the census furnishes villagewise and in respect of towns, enumerator's blockwise particulars of households, sexwise population, scheduled tribes, literacy and categorisation of workers and non-workers. The State Primary Census Abstract which is a consolidated statement of the Census returns of the Circles will also furnish the above particulars. The Hand Book is enriched with a District Map showing the Sub-Divisional and Circle boundaries (notional) and the location of their H. Qs. The names of villages with population of 1,000 and above are also shown in the District Map along with some major amenities such as Police Stations, Hospitals, Primary Health Centres, Dispensaries, Child and Maternity Welfare Centres, National Highways etc. Before the villagewise Primary Census Abstracts are presented, a Circle Map showing the location of villages with some amenities is also added. Besides the Maps, lists of villages of the Circles are also given in alphabetical order. Hence, the D. C. H. Part A & B will be a self-contained and comprehensive reference book concerning the various statistics of Mokokchung district.

I am deeply indebted to the State Government for their ever willing help and unstinted efforts to get this publication printed in time. The then Chief Secretary Shri R. Kathing, I. F. A. S. and his successor Shri L. Lungalang, I. A. S., took a very keen interest for the successful completion of the 1971 census in the State. They had always been the sources of helping hands in sorting out administrative matters and problems pertaining to Census.

I would be failing in my duty if I do not record my grateful thanks to the entire district census machinery—Deputy Commissioners, Sub-Divisional Officers (Civil), Extra-Assistant Commissioners/Circle Officers, Supervisors and Enumerators for their ever willing co-operation and sincere works. I am also grateful to the Director of Education and his entire formation down to village level teachers who formed the army of enumerators. My thanks go to Shri P. N. I am also grateful to the Director and his colleagues of All India Radio, Kohima for giving me facilities in making publicity during the operations of 1971 Census.

In this connection, I express my deep debt of gratitude to the master planners of the Indian Census of 1971, Shri A. Chandra Sekhar, I. A. S., Registrar General and Census Commissioner, India who has been the constant source of inspiration and guidance. The prompt and painstaking Deputy Registrar General, Shri K. D. Ballal, I. A. S., and the Asstt. Registrar general, Shri K. K. Chakravarty also helped us to get the tables checked with accuracy. The Map Officer of R. G's office Dr. B. K. Roy rendered valuable guidance in preparing the maps for this publication.

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INTRODUCTORY NOTES ON DISTRICT CENSUS HAND BOOK

The publication of District Census Handbooks was first introduced in the 1951 Census long before Nagaland attained statehood. In the 1961 Census attempts were fully made to publish the District Census Handbook but when it reached the editing stage the entire work had to suffer a set back and subsequently it had to be dropped mainly because of delays.

In the 1971 Census good efforts have been put in to compile both the Census and non-census data at village and town level in a wide range and uniform manner with an enlarged scope. This was taken in view of growing consciousness and demands for statistical data by the State Government machinery and Local bodies for administrative, planning and developmental purposes. This book will definitely serve as a reference book pertaining to the district. The delay in the publication of this book will reduce the importance and value of this useful publication. In order to avoid delay in publication and to ensure that the data are made available to the data users the District Census Handbook is sub-divided into three parts, viz., Part-A, Part-B and Part-C, two of which (Part-A and Part-B) are combined together in one volume for the district of Mokokchung. The scope of each part of the D. C. H. is as follows :-

Scope of Part-A

The District Census Handbook — Part-A contains the Village and Town Directory.

The Village Directory portion gives particulars of amenities available for each village in the matter of educational and medical institutions, power supply, drinking water facilities, post and telegraph facilities, communications, particulars of land use, weekly markets and places

of religious, historical or archaeological interest in the village.

The Town Directory portion gives the data for each town in the District in the form of seven statements which cover (1) the status of the civic administration, the growth of population since 1901 and the functional category; (2) physical aspects and location of towns for 1969; (3) municipal finance for 1968-69; (4) civic and other amenities; (5) medical, educational, recreational and cultural facilities for 1969; (6) trade, commerce, industry and banking for 1969 and (7) population by religion for 1971 Census.

Scope of Part-B

The District Census Handbook — Part - B contains the Village and Town Primary Census Abstract.

This part gives for each village and for each enumerator's block of a town the primary census data incorporating area in square kilometre, the number of occupied residential houses, the number of households, total population and its break up by sex, scheduled caste and scheduled tribe population, literate population and working population classified by nine industrial categories and non-working population.

The nine industrial categories of workers are as follows :

- (i) Cultivators
- (ii) Agricultural labourers
- (iii) In livestock, forestry, fishing, hunting & plantation, orchards and allied activities.
- (iv) In mining and quarrying

- (v) In manufacturing, processing, servicing and repairs
 - (a) Household Industry
 - (b) Other than household Industry
- (vi) In construction
- (vii) In trade and commerce
- (viii) In transport, storage and communication
- (ix) In other services

Scope of Part-C

The District Census Handbook — Part-C will contain the administrative statistics of the district in different fields of development. This part will further incorporate the census tables regarding language, religion, migration etc. pertaining to the district. A write up indicating the changes in the socio-economic and demographic characteristics of the district in the last decade will also be given

NOTES ON VILLAGE DIRECTORY

The Village Directory presents particulars regarding

- (a) amenities in terms of educational, medical, power supply, drinking water, communication and postal and telegraphic facilities available in the villages
- (b) important staple food consumed by the majority of the population of the villages during the major portion of the year. In some villages it may be difficult to clearly determine a particular grain used as a staple food crop. In such cases the combination of grains mainly used as staple food, e. g., rice and millet and jobsteers or rice and millet or rice and jobsteers have been indicated in the Village Directory
- (c) Land use pattern
- (d) nearest town to the villages and its distance in kilometres
- (e) day or days of the market/hat, if any, held in the village
- (f) place of religious, historical and archaeological interest.

Circle-wise abstract of educational, medical and other amenities have been shown in an appendix after the Village Directory of the district.

The abbreviations used in the Village Directory are as follows :

Educations :

- Pr.S = Primary School
- Mid.S = Middle school or Junior secondary school
- Sec.S. = Secondary school (High School) or Higher Secondary School
- C = College

(a) **Distribution of villages by area**

The distribution of the villages with reference to their area could not be discussed here as the area figures for the villages are not available because of the reason that the villages in Nagaland have not so far been cadastrally surveyed.

(b) **Distribution of villages by educational amenities**

The distribution of villages having educational amenities with reference to the distance of the villages from the nearest town is shown in the following table.

From the above table it appears that 79, 121 and 49 number of villages fall within the

distance group of 26 to 50 Kms., 51 to 100 Kms. and 101 to 200 Kms. respectively from the

nearest town. In other words out of the total number of 326 villages in the district 249 villages fall within the distance group of 26 to 200 Kms. Out of the 326 villages 268 villages enjoy the facilities of Primary Schools, 63 villages with Middle Schools and 14 villages with High/Higher Secondary/Secondary Schools. There is no College in rural areas of the district.

(c) **Medical facilities**

Out of 326 villages 63 villages are having

medical facilities in the district.

(d) **Power Supply**

Only 32 villages have electricity which constitute 9.82 percent of the total number of villages. The distribution of villages with electric power supply by distance from the nearest town is shown in the following table.

Out of 326 villages, 39 villages are connected with Pucca road and 242 villages with Kutcha road. The number of villages having facility of Pucca road and Kutcha road within the distance group of 26 to 50 Kms. are 16 and 56 respectively. Further, 6 villages connected with Pucca road and 83 villages with Kutcha road fall under the distance group of 51 to 100 Kms. from the nearest town.

(f) **Postal and Telegraph facilities**

Only 30 villages in the district have been provided with postal facilities while there is no telegraph facility at all.

(g) **Staple food**

Rice is used as the main staple food in some Circles. The combination of rice, maize and jobsteer is used as staple food in villages of some circles in the district of Mokokchung.



NOTES ON TOWN DIRECTORY

The definition of an urban unit as adopted in the Census is as follows :

- (i) All places with a municipality, corporation or cantonment or a notified town area
- (ii) All other places which satisfy the following criteria are also recognised as towns
 - (1) a minimum population of 5,000
 - (2) at least 75 percent of the male working population is non-agricultural and
 - (3) a density of population of at least 1,000 per square mile or 400 per square Km.

All the towns are classified into the following six categories according to prescribed population.

1. Class I — with a population of 100,000 and above.
2. Class II — with a population of 50,000 to 99,999.
3. Class III — with a population of 20,000 to 49,999.
4. Class IV — with a population of 10,000 to 19,999.
5. Class V — with a population of 5,000 to 9,999.
6. Class VI — with a population of less than 5,000.

Class I town with a population of 100,000 and above is termed as a city in the Census. There is no city in this State. There is only one town (Class IV) in the district of Mokokchung. No new town has come up in this district during the decade of 1961-71.

The town Directory portion contains seven statements which are explained below.

STATEMENT 1

This statement gives the information on the status of the town, decadal population since the

year 1901 and functional categories as observed in the 1971 Census. Abbreviation used in the statement is as follows :

T.C. = Town Committee.

The following tables gives the functional category of the town.

We may now make an attempt to classify the towns according to the predominant functional characteristics of the town. A classification is attempted on the basis of the proportion of workers in various industrial categories of workers in each town. According to census the workers are classified into nine categories of economic activities.

The nine industrial categories of workers grouped into five sectors are given below.

Group No.	Functional characters	Industrial Categories
1	Primary activities	I, II, III & IV
2	Industry	V & VI
3	Trade and Commerce	VII
4	Transport	VIII
5	Services	IX

For each town the percentage of workers to the total workers under each of the above five groups is calculated and the functional character of the town is determined according to their percentage values.

(I) If the workers under one of the occupations form 40 percent or above of the total workers then it will be a monofunctional i.e., Primary activities or Industry or Service.

(II) If the percentage falling under any of

the sector as mentioned above is less than 40 percent then the next predominant sector is taken into account so that their total reaches 3/5 th of the working population i.e., 60 percent. Such a town is designated as industry cum trade and commerce or transport cum service as the figures indicate.

(III) If the percentage of two predominant sectors does not come to 60 percent then the third predominant sector is taken into account to form 60 percent and such a town is designated as trade and commerce cum transport cum service or industry cum service cum transport as the figures indicate.

It has been mentioned earlier also that Mokokchung town is the only town exists in the district which has a functional character of service.

Statement II

This statement gives the physical aspects and location of the town as on 1969. Under the physical aspects the statement furnishes information relating to annual rainfall in mili-

metre and temperature in centigrade. The statement further furnishes the distance of the town from the nearest city with population of one lakh and above, distance from the State Head Quarters, District Head Quarters, Sub-divisional Head Quarters, the nearest railway station and the bus route.

STATEMENT III

This statement shows the details of the municipal finance for the year 1968-69. The total receipts and the total expenditures are rounded off in terms of Rs. '00'. The statement covers the receipts under different heads like receipt through taxes, revenue derived from municipal properties and powers apart from taxation, Government grants, loan, advances and other sources. Like wise the expenditures incurred are shown under different heads such as expenditures on general administration, public safety, public health and conveniences, public works, public institutions and others.

The following table shows the per capita receipts and expenditures of the municipal finance of Mokokchung Town.

STATEMENT IV

This statement presents the extent of civic and other amenities available as in 1969. It furnishes information on the type of road with length in Km., system of sewerage/drainage, number of latrines of different types, method of disposal of night soil, source and capacity of protected water supply, existence of fire fighting services, number of electric connections separately under domestic, industrial, commercial and also the number of road lighting points.

The abbreviations used in this statement are as follows :

- PR = Pucca Road
- KR = Kutcha Road
- OSD = Open surface drainage
- ST = Septic tank latrines
- R = River

The town has open surface drainage. Underground sewerage system is yet to be provided. Thus the position of drainage system in Mokokchung town is not satisfactory. Service latrines out number the water borne latrines in the town. The town has septic tanks for disposal of night soil. Water is supplied to the people from the river. From this statement it is seen that only 48,000 gallons of water are supplied per day which accounts for 2 gallons per capita per day.

STATEMENT V

This statement presents the information relating to medical, educational, recreational and cultural facilities in the town of the district for the year 1969.

Under the heading 'medical facilities' the number separately of hospitals, Dispensaries, T. B. Clinics, Health centres, Nursing Homes are shown in the statement. As regards the 'educational facilities' the number of Arts/Science/Commerce College, Medical College, Engineering College, Polytechnics, recognised short hand, type writing and other vocational training institutions, Higher Secondary or Secondary Schools, Junior Secondary/middle Schools, Primary schools are also given. Under the heading 'Recreational and cultural facilities' the number of Studios, Cinemas, Auditoria/Drama halls and Public Libraries including Reading Rooms are also indicated in the Statement.

Abbreviations used in this Statement are as follows :

- H = Hospital
- D = Dispensary
- TBC = T.B. Clinic
- A = Arts College

The town of Mokokchung has one hospital, one dispensary and one T. B. Clinic. The extent of medical facilities is shown with the help of the following table.

PRIMARY CENSUS ABSTRACT**



EXPLANATORY NOTES

The District Census Hand Book Part-B will furnish information on the number of occupied residential houses, total population by sex, scheduled tribes, literates and educated persons, workers classified by nine industrial categories and non-workers.

The definitions of the Census terms used in this book are explained below :-

Census House :— A "Census House" is a building or part of a building having a separate main entrance from the road or common courtyard or stair-case etc., used or recognised as a separate unit. It may be inhabited or vacant. It may be used for a residential or non-residential purpose or both.

Households :— A household is a group of persons who commonly live together and would take their meals from a common kitchen unless the exigencies of work prevented any of them from doing so. There may be one-member household, two-member household or multi-member household. For Census purposes each one of these types is regarded as a 'Household'. Again, there may be a household of persons related by blood or household of unrelated persons, the latter are Boarding House, Hostels, Residential Hotels, Orphanages, Rescue Homes, Ashrams etc. These are called 'Institutional Household'.

Scheduled Tribes :—They are members of the tribes who generally occupy the hilly areas or other rather inaccessible part of the Indian Union. They are generally backward and so the Government of India has prepared a schedule of such tribes for the purpose of giving them facilities in education and employment so that they may come up to the level of other advanced people of India as soon as possible. Scheduled tribes may belong to any religion.

In the 1971 Census no other caste or community other than those who belong to the Scheduled Tribes of Nagaland recorded as Scheduled tribes. A list of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes of Nagaland as notified in the Order of the President and as modified in the scheduled castes and scheduled tribes Modification order, 1956 and as amended from time to time is reproduced below.

1. Naga
2. Kuki
3. Kachari
4. Mikir
5. Garo

It should be noted that there is no Scheduled Caste in Nagaland as per the Constitution (Nagaland) Scheduled Tribes Order, 1970.

It should also be noted that only persons whose tribes are found within Nagaland according to the President's Order are recorded as Scheduled Tribes of Nagaland. It therefore follows that, as for example, a Khasi who may be scheduled tribe of Meghalaya can not be recorded as a scheduled tribe of Nagaland. Such people were recorded on the same category as the general population of the State.

Literate and Educated persons :— A person who can both read and write with understanding in any language is to be taken as a literate. A person who can merely read but cannot write is not a literate. It is not necessary that a person who is literate should have received any formal education or should have passed any minimum educational standard. All children of the age of 4 years or less are treated as illiterate even if the child is going to a school and may have picked up reading and writing a few odd words.

Workers :— A 'Worker' is a person whose main activity is participation in any economically productive work physically or mentally. Work involves not only actual work but effective supervision and direction of work.

When the main activity of a person qualifies him/her to be treated as a worker he/she is further categorised according to the type of work he/she performs. There are nine categories of workers as follows :—

- Category I Working as cultivator
- Category II Working as Agricultural Labourer.
- Category III Working in Livestock, Forestry, Fishing, Hunting & Plantation, Orchards & Allied activities.
- Category IV Mining and Quarrying
- Category V Manufacturing, Processing, Servicing & Repairs.
 - (a) Working at Household Industry.
 - (b) Other than Household Industry.
- Category VI Working in construction.
- Category VII Working in trade and Commerce.
- Category VIII Working in Transport, Storage and Communication.
- Category IX Working in other services.

Cultivator :— For the purpose of the Census a person is working as cultivator if he or she is engaged in cultivation by self or by supervision or direction in one's capacity as the owner or lessee of land hold from Government or as a tenant of land hold from private persons or institutions for payment or money, kind or share.

Agricultural Labourer :— A person who works in another person's land for wages in cash or kind should be regarded as an agricultural

labourer. He has no risk in the cultivation but he merely works in another person's land for wages.

Household Industry :— A Household Industry is defined as an industry conducted by the Head of the Household himself/herself and/or mainly by the members of the household at home or within the village in rural areas and only within the premises of the house where the households live in urban areas.

The industry should not be run on the scales of a registered factory.

A Household Industry should relate to production, processing, servicing, repairing or making and selling (but not merely selling) of goods. It does not include professions such as a pleader or doctor or barber, musician, dancer, water man, dhobi, astrologer, etc., or merely trade or business, even if such professions, trade or services are run at home by members of household.

Non-worker :— A "Non-worker" is a person whose main activity is not engaged in any economically productive work. Non-workers are categorised under seven broad head as follows :

1. **Household Duties :—** A person engaged in unpaid home duties (like housewife or other adult female) who does no other work, such as make articles at home for sale or wage, nor help regularly even part-time in family cultivation, industry, trade or business.

2. **Student :—** A student is a person whose main activity is returned as a student. This will cover all fulltime students or children attending school. Even if such persons participated in some work but not to the same extent as a fulltime worker, by merely helping casually as an unpaid family worker in family cultivation, household industry, trade or business, they should be treated primarily as student if that is their main activity.

3. Retired person or A Rentier :—A person who has retired from service and is doing no other work i.e., not employed again in some fulltime work or does not engage himself in some other work as cultivation, in business, trade etc., or a person who is a rentier or living on agricultural or non-agricultural royalty, rent or dividend, or any other person of independent means for securing which he does not have to work will be treated as non-worker.

4. Dependent :— This category includes all dependents such as infants or children not attending school or a person permanently disabled from work because of illness or old age. Dependents include all non-workers even if able bodied who have no other activity coming under any of the categories of non-workers and who are not seeking any work but are purely dependent.

5. Beggars etc. :— This includes baggars, vagrants or such cases as independent woman without indication of source of income and those of unspecified sources of sub-sistence and who are not engaged in any economically productive work.

6. Living in Institutions :— This covers convicts in jail or inmates of a penal, mental or charitable Institution even if such persons are compelled to do some work such as carpentry, carpet weaving, vegetable growing etc., in such institutions. An under-trial prisoner in a jail should not, however, be brought under this category but is to be indicated according to the main activity he was engaged before he was apprehended.

7. Other Non-workers :— This includes all non-workers who may not come under any of the six categories above but are seeking work. A boy or girl who has completed education or has stopped studying and is seeking work, will come under this category. A person irrespective of age and whether educated or not if he reports that he is not engaged in any other activity but is seeking work will come under this category.

POPULATION

The District of Mokokchung with an area of 3,852.0 Square Kilometres has a population of 168,242 out of which 88,256 are males and 79,986 are females as recorded in the 1971 Census. The population of 1971 Census has shown an increase of 42,241 persons over that of 1961 Census and an increase of 60,351 persons over 1951 Census. The percentages decennial growth of population are 16.79 and 33.52 for 1951-61¹ and 1961-71 respectively. The decade 1961-71 has shown the highest decennial growth compared to earlier decades.

The District has only one town, namely Mokokchung Town. It has a population of 17,423 out of which 12,298 are males and 5,125 are females. In 1961 the population of the town was 6,158. The percentage decennial growth of population as observed during 1961-71 is 182.93.

The sex ratio in the district is 906 females per 1,000 males which has fallen than that of the 1961 Census (958). Further, the sex-ratio in Mokokchung town is 417 females for every 1,000 males, while it was 647 in 1961 Census. This fall of sex-ratio may be due to the influx of males to the town for the sake of education, employment and business.

The density of population per square kilometre in the district is 44 as against 31 in the State while it was 25 in 1961 Census. The density of population per square kilometre in Mokokchung town is 1,121.

The District consists of 23 circles. They are (1) Ongpangkong, (2) Chuchuyimlang, (3) Tuli, (4) Alongkima, (5) Kobulong, (6) Longchem, (7) Mangkulemba, (8) Changtongya, (9) Zunheboto, (10) Aghunato, (11) Satakha, (12) Suruhoto, (13) Akuluto, (14) Atoizu, (15) Satoi, (16) Hoshepu, (17) Achikuchu, (18) Wokha, (19) Sanis, (20) Bhandari, (21) Lotsu, (22) Aitepyong, (23) Sungro.

Among the circles, Wokha circle has recorded the highest population (19,936) and next to it comes the Ongpangkong circle (18,242). The lowest population (511) has been recorded in Mangkulemba circle. The highest sex-ratio of 1,178 females for every 1,000 males is observed in Sungro circle and the lowest in Zunheboto circle (782 females per 1,000 males). The circles which are having greater number of females per 1,000 males are Sungro (1,178), Hoshepu (1,112), Suruhoto (1,087), Atoizu (1,065), Ongpangkong (1,053), Satakha (1,027), Satoī (1,025), Aghunato (1,023), Aitepyong (1,021), Akuluto (1,018), Kobulong (1,009), Chuchuyimlong (1,009), Alongkima (1,001).

38.15 per cent of the population of the district are literate. This literacy rate of the district is higher than that of the State rate of 27.40 per cent. In the Mokokchung town 62.10 per cent of the people are literate. 65.15 per cent of the urban males and 54.77 per cent of the urban females are literate. Among the circles the highest rate of literacy is observed

in Mangkulemba circle (60.47%). The lowest literacy rate is recorded in Aghunato circle (16.81%). The circles which are having literacy rates above the district rate are Mangkulemba (60.47%), Alongkima (57.43%), Longchem (52.53%), Tuli (52.52%), Kobulong (47.59%), Changtongya (41.65%), Ongpangkong (39.40%).

91.30 per cent of the population of the district are Scheduled Tribes. In Mokokchung Town they form 47.98 per cent.

It is observed that 46.63 per cent of the population are workers and 53.37 per cent are non-workers in the district. In Mokokchung Town 53.28 per cent are workers and 46.72 per cent non-workers.

Nagaland basically is an agricultural state. 79.03 per cent of the total workers of the State are agriculturists. Agriculturists form 76.85 per cent in the district.

In the district of Mokokchung there are 326 inhabited villages.

GRAPH SHOWING THE POPULATION TREND FROM 1901 TO 1971- MOKOKCHUNG DIST:





CHART SHOWING THE CIRCLE WISE DISTRIBUTION OF POPULATION —1971, MOKOKCHUNG DISTRICT

LITERACY RATES, 1971



