




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P R E F A C E

The Rajauri district falling between $74^{\circ} - 0'$ to $74^{\circ} - 40'$ East longitude and $32^{\circ} - 58'$ to $33^{\circ} - 35'$ North latitude and encompassing an area of 2,681 square kilometers, is the newest of State's districts having been carved as such for ensuring greater administrative convenience during the intercensal period (September 1967). The district is made up of three constituent tehsils, Budhal, Rajauri and Nowshehra which at the 1961 Census formed part of the Punch district. Rajauri, the headquarter, lies at a distance of 177 kms from Jammu and is connected by a good metalled road.

Rajauri is famous in history a 'Rajour'—the land of Rajas. During the Mughal times, it served as an important stage in the journey to the vale of Kashmir which lies across the adjacent Pir Panjal range. A spot on the old Mughal route is still known as Noor-i-Chamb because it is believed that Noor Jehan 'the light of the world' would pause here, on her way to Kashmir, to relax and bathe. At a short distance from Rajauri, as the road descends towards the plains of Nowshehra, are situated the ruins of Chingas where lie buried the entrails of Jehangir with only a plain stone slab announcing this tragic but historically important event. It was from Rajauri that Maharaja Ranjit Singh in recent times planned the invasion of Kashmir. It shot into news again when in 1965 armed bands from Pakistan crossed over stealthily in the area in a determined bid to seize the State by force. In consequence, till law and order was restored and the raiders pushed back, parts of the district remained in an unsettled condition upsetting its normal life and economy.

The 1971 Census shows that within just over half a decade the district appeared to be recovering from the ravages suffered by it in 1965. Accounting for a population of 171,529 persons in 1961, it rose to 217,373 in 1971 or +26.73% during the decade. The percentage of literacy returned for the district which was only 7.37 in 1961 rose to 14.43 in 1971, nearly double of the previous figure. The proportion of workers to total population may serve as a good index in determining the extent to which the population is employed in economic pursuits. We see on the basis of 1971 Census data that the number of persons classified as workers in

the district gives out a total of 60,106 which makes a proportion of 27.65% compared to 24.44% of the relatively more well-placed Jammu district. However, in consequence of the modification of the definition of worker at the 1971 Census, the district has shared in the over-all fall in the figure of workers registered at the State level which is also true of all other districts. But at the same time it is worthy of mention that 'other workers' in the district make a percentage of 18.08 as against 14.47 in 1961 suggesting greater diversification of occupations. In the sphere of urbanisation, the district has recorded inter-decadal growth rate of 36.31% as compared to 15.48% and 26.12% of Baramula and Doda districts respectively although it has only two towns, Rajauri and Nowshehra, which are placed in class V and class VI towns respectively.

The district abounding in low-lying grassy hills offers considerable scope for the development of animal husbandry especially sheep-breeding. As a matter of fact, rearing of cattle is already a widely adopted profession in these parts. Introduction of better breeds simultaneously with launching of intensive measures of veterinary welfare etc. would prove a positive help to its dominant pastoral economy. There is no dearth of places in the district whose natural attractions could be exploited to attract tourists and consequently tourism offers yet another rich opening in its economy. There is also a bright prospect for setting up of cottage industries.

The present District Census Handbook like the volumes published earlier in the series consists of two parts; part A comprising the town and village directories of the district and part B, the village and town-wise primary census abstract based on the 1971 Census returns. The information given out is built on data from the lowest administrative unit, the village, mohalla/ward upwards to the district. The book has been supplemented with latest jurisdictional maps of its three constituent tehsils and district as a whole to interest the reader.

In preparing this volume, I would like to make special mention of S/Shri A.M. Kalloo, Tabulation Officer (Social Studies) and P. K. Khosa Statistical Assistant, who assisted me in the work.

INTRODUCTORY NOTE ON TOWN AND VILLAGE DIRECTORY

Origin and growth of District Census Handbooks.

The District Census Handbooks were published for the first time in 1951 as part of the Census publication programme in almost all States of India except Jammu and Kashmir where due to unsettled conditions prevailing in the wake of Pakistani invasion of 1947-48 no Census could be undertaken and no data was collected for the decade 1941-51. Even prior to 1951, some States used to produce District Census Statistics. No attempt of the kind appears to have been made in Jammu and Kashmir in an uninterrupted manner. The usual practice prevailing was to publish the population figures on the basis of communities and adding other details in the two parts of the General Report. From 1951 onwards information provided in the Primary Census Abstract was built up on 8 livelihood classes. The series of District Census Handbooks taken up for the first time at the 1951 Census fulfilled a long-felt need. These gave out not only the data contained in P. C. A. according to the new classification but included a succinct account of the district and its people, Census tables and a host of other data covering such topics as housing, communication, education, public health etc., regarding each town and village of the district. At the 1961 Census, a uniform frame was adopted adding a lot more useful information in the volumes which were besides supplemented with maps, tables etc.

Scope of 1971 District Census Handbooks

Further improvements have been effected to the series at this Census not only by way of enlarging their scope and content but presenting the data in three parts A, B & C, with parts A & B consisting of Town & Village Directories and P. C. A. respectively fused into one volume. This departure in the earlier method of presentation is intended to eliminate delay and make readily available information reach the data-users in advance of Part C of series containing administrative statistics etc., the collection of which is bound to take time. Let us make a brief mention of the scope of each part:—

Part A : Town & Village Directory

It furnishes information about each town and village of the district. The Town Directory covers such items as status of civic administration, growth of population since 1901, functional characteristics of the towns at the 1961 and 1971 Censuses, physical aspects and location, civic finances, civic and other amenities, medical, educational, recreational and cultural facilities, trade, industry, commerce and banking facilities and distribution of population by religion.

The Village Directory portion gives particulars of amenities available in each village of the district in the matter of educational and medical institutions; power supply; drinking water; post and telegraph facilities; communication; particulars of land use statistics and places of religious, historical and archaeological importance in the village.

Part B : Primary Census Abstract

This part of the publication is exclusively based on 1971 Census data. It provides information in respect of each village and ward/mohalla of a town in the district in respect of its area; number of residential houses; number of households; total population with sex-wise break up; scheduled caste population; literate and educated persons and working population by nine industrial categories and non-working population.

Part C : Administrative Statistics & Report

This part of the District Census Handbook which will come out as a separate volume will incorporate administrative statistics and Census tables. An analytical report indicating the socio-economic and demographic changes the district has experienced during the last decade.

Explanatory Note on Town Directory

The Town Directory portion of the publication which consists of seven statements throws useful light on economic cultural, and demographic traits of each town. Before we attempt an appraisal of the data incorporated in these statements, it would be of interest to mention here the Census definition of a town:

A standard definition of town was evolved for the first time at the 1961 Census and with slight

modification it was adopted at this Census also. In this definition the following criteria were prescribed for treating a village or an area as urban :-

- a) all places with a Municipality, Corporation or Town Committee or a Notified Area or a Cantonment Board irrespective of their population and other characteristics.
- b) all other places satisfying the following tests :-
 - 1. an area/village whose population is not below 5,000;
 - 2. an area/village whose $\frac{1}{4}$ th of male working population consists of non-agriculturists; and
 - 3. an area which has a density of not less than 1,000 persons per Sq. mile (390 persons per km²)

The district which is of recent origin, having been carved out of Punch district has only two towns, namely Nowshehra and Rajaouri. While both the towns fulfil the condition at (a), it is only Rajaouri,— the seat of district headquarter— which satisfies all the tests laid down in criterion (b). It deserves to be mentioned here that, during the last one decade, Rajaouri alone has been able to improve its urban status, having scrambled from Class VI to Class V town. Nowshehra continues to be a Class VI town with population below 5,000.

Data Content:

We may now give a broad analysis of the data contained in the statements of the Town Directory.

STATEMENT—I

This statement gives the 1971 Census location Code number ; the civic administration status as in 1970, the growth history since 1901 and the functional category as determined at the 1961 and 1971 Censuses of the two towns of the District.

Both the towns are Notified Areas. Their civic administration status has accordingly been indicated in Column 5 in the abbreviated form 'N. A.'

The chronological history of the two towns since 1901, reveals that Rajaouri acquired urban status for the first time in 1911 and continues

to enjoy this status since. Nowshehra, on the other hand, was declared urban only at the 1961 Census.

Columns 12 and 13 of the statement, will show that during the last ten years the urban population of the district has increased by 2,237 persons making a decennial growth rate of 36.31%. This is much lower than the urban growth rate of 44.65% recorded for the State as a whole. Between the two towns, Rajaouri has fared better with a growth rate of 41.54% as against Nowshehra having recorded a growth rate of only 25.15%.

Functional Classification :

Cols. 14 and 15 of the statement portraying functional characteristics of the two towns as at 1961 and 1971 Censuses, has a special significance for administrative agencies in as much as it reveals the role of these towns in such fields as Commerce, Industry, Transport, Communications, Services, Construction, Education etc.

For determining the functional characteristics, the nine Industrial Categories have been condensed into the following five broad groups :-

For either town, the proportion of workers in each of the above 5 classes of economic activity has been calculated. If the proportion of workers under any of the above five categories was found to be 40% or more, the town has been treated as mono-functional e.g. Industrial Commercial, Transport etc.

If the proportion, on the other hand, under

any of the above categories was recorded less than 40%, but when added with the next predominant category came to 60% or more, the town has been classified as bi-functional e.g., Primary Activities-cum-Services, Industry-cum-Trade and Commerce etc.

Likewise, if the proportion of 3 most predominant categories came to 60% or more, the town has been designated as Tri-functional e.g., Primary Activities - cum - Services - cum - Trade & Commerce etc.

At the 1961 Census, as the statement will show, Rajaouri was a mono-functional town with 'Services' as its functional characteristic and Nowshera a bi-functional town with Primary Activities-cum-Services, as its functional traits. During the last decade, however, Nowshera has also become a mono-functional town.

STATEMENT-II

This statement is intended to portray physical and locational aspects of the two towns like annual rainfall (in mm's), maximum and minimum temperatures (in centigrade), distance of the town from the nearest city with a population of 1 lakh and more, distance from the State, District and Tehsil Headquarters, from the Railway Station, if any, and bus route, existance of navigable river/canal, if within 10 kms. and the Sea Port, if any, within 50 kms. from the town.

However no information on annual rainfall, maximum and minimum temperature has become available in respect of either town.

Rajaouri is the youngest district of the State, having come into being during the inter-census period of 1961-71 by detaching Nowshera and Rajaouri tehsils from the erstwhile Punch district. The district is located between $32^{\circ}-58'$ to $33^{\circ}-35'$ north latitude and $74^{\circ}-0'$ to $74^{\circ}-40'$ east longitude.

The district partly falls in the "Outer Hills" and partly in the sub-mountain region. The whole of Budhal tehsil and greater part of Rajaouri tehsil fall within "Outer Hills" and the rest of the district comes under sub-mountain division. Barring low level areas of Nowshera tehsil, the entire district is criss-crossed by streams and rivers, besides being mountainous in character. Very few of these streams are capable of irrigation, others mainly depend on

rains and sometimes become formidable when in spate.

Climatic conditions in the district fluctuate according to elevation and aspect. All low lying areas of Nowshera and Rajaouri tehsils experience hot and dry spells during summer. High elevated areas particularly mountain slopes are pleasantly cool in summer and cold in winter.

The district falls in what is called dark green belt region and wherefore the average annual rainfall is invariably more than 50". Much of this copious rainfall however goes down the drain unutilized because of the mountainous character of the district and scarcity of cultivable land.

In 1969, Pathankote was the nearest Railway Station for both towns of the district with the subsequent extension of the Railway line right upto Jammu, the position has altogether changed. Jammu is now the nearest available Railway Station for both the towns.

Both towns of the district enjoy bus route facilities. There is, however, no navigable river/canal passing either through the urban areas or any other part of the district.

STATEMENT-III

This statement gives the 1968-69 budgetary picture of the two towns of the district. The statement is broadly divided into the receipt and expenditure heads. Under the receipt head, the data has been collected under six sub-heads namely receipt through taxes ; receipt derived from Municipal properties ; government grant ; loans ; advances and other sources. Likewise, the expenditure head has been split into sub-heads, like general administration ; public safety ; public health and conveniences ; public works ; public institution and others.

The figures in the statement have been rounded off to hundred to facilitate presentation.

We may now examine the per capita receipt and expenditure of the two towns by size class.

The table discloses that per capita receipt and expenditure is higher in Nowshehra than in Rajauri town, the figures stand at Rs. 24.82 and Rs. 16.23 respectively. Rajauri the district headquarter, is, however, the only town which shows a per capita expenditure of Rs. 8.30 on public health and convenience.

There is practically no expenditure on public institutions in both the towns of the district. In view of their tight resources position the local bodies have to restrict the scope of their activities to very limited public utility services.

STATEMENT—IV

This statement gives the particulars of civic and other amenities available in the two towns of the district. The information encompassed in the statement pertains to the year 1968-69 and covers such items as length of road maintained by the local bodies; system of sewerage; number and type of latrines; method of disposal of nightsoil; source and capacity of drinking water. The statement also indicates the number of electric connections under sub-heads like domestic; industrial; commercial; road lighting points and others.

The following abbreviations have been used in this statement :-

Column 4 :

PD : Pucca Drainage

Column 8 :

TS : Trench system
H : Hand-cart

Column 9 :

TW : Tube Well
S : Spring
W : Well

Roads :

Column 3 of the statement gives the length of road under the exclusive supervision and maintenance of the local bodies. As per available information, the two towns claim, in all, a road length of 23 kms. maintained by local bodies, of which Rajauri alone accounts for more than 65%. It would have been more useful to have the classification of these roads into kutchha, pucca etc; but these details are not available with the concerned local bodies.

Drainage System :

There are no sewers in use in either town. The prevalent system is that of pucca surface drains.

Sanitation :

Water-borne latrines are non-existent. Of the two towns, Rajauri is served by 500 service-type latrines and Nowshehra by 175 other type latrines.

Night soil, garbage etc. is removed outside urban limits through hand-carts where it is buried in deep-dug trenches.

Water Supply :

Both towns, however, enjoy protecting drinking water facilities. The sources of supply are springs and wells. Reservoirs of varying capacities have been installed in the two towns to ensure regular supply of potable water. On the basis of a norm of 30 gallons per head per day, the requirements of Rajauri town, the district headquarter, are in the neighbourhood of 1,78,200 gallons. The installed capacity of the reservoir however stands only at 1,45,000 gallons. In the case of Nowshehra town, the position is much better. As against the requirement of 73,700 gallons, the existing capacity of the reservoir is 1,25,000 gallons.

Fire-fighting Facilities :

Upto the year 1969, neither of the towns was provided with fire-fighting facilities. This can indeed be a serious deficiency in the event of out-break of a fire, as there is no other town nearly to draw upon for such assistance.

Electricity :

Both towns are electrified. The electricity consumption figures classified by uses like domestic, industrial, commercial, road lighting and others however make a poor picture. Lack of adequate supply of electricity acts as a big bottleneck in perpetuating the industrial backwardness of these towns.

STATEMENT—V

This statement brings out the medical, educational, recreational and cultural amenities available in the two towns of the district. Under medical facilities are given the type of institution and number of beds available. Similarly, under educational facilities different types of educational institutions located in the towns have been indicated. Information regarding the availability of stadia, cinema houses, drama halls and libraries has been covered under the head recreational and cultural facilities.

The abbreviations used in Column 3 of the statement are amplified below :—

H : Hospital

HC : Health Centre

FC : Family Planning Centre

Medical Facilities :

The medical facilities available in the two towns consist of one hospital, one health centre and one family planning centre. The hospital and the family planning centre located in Rajauri, the district headquarter and the health centre is located in Nowshehra. As per the position obtaining in 1969, there are in all, 65 beds available in these institutions to cater not only to the in-patients of the two towns but also those of suburban areas. 50 of these beds are placed in the hospital in Rajauri town and the remaining 15 in the health centre in Nowshehra town.

The following table gives the number of beds available per 1,000 of population in each town of the district.

The table reveals that if we only take into consideration the local population of the two towns, there are 7.7 beds available for every 1,000 persons. Rajauri town is better placed with a ratio of 8.4 beds per 1,000 population, as compared to Nowshehra, with a ratio of 6.1 beds per 1,000 population. The variation is, however, understandable in as much as the hospital at Rajauri is expected to serve the requirements of the district as a whole.

Educational Facilities :

There is no College in either town for post-matric education. Those of the students who are keen to receive higher education have to go all the way to Punch town or Jammu city for the purpose.

The Vocational Training Institute offering guides in various trades, considered a must in the present set up, is not found in any of its towns.

The primary and secondary school education in the two towns is provided by 4 higher secondary/high schools, one junior secondary/middle school, 3 primary schools and 2 other schools. Rajauri town has no middle school. Its two higher secondary/high schools provide middle school education also. The following table gives the number of schools of each type per 1,000 population :—

The table shows that in the provision of educational facilities Nowshehra is better placed than Rajauri despite the fact that the latter constitutes the district headquarter.

Recreational and Cultural Facilities :

Barring a lone library room in Nowshehra, nothing can be seen in the two towns which could contribute to the promotion of recreational and cultural activity of people. There are no stadia, cinema theatre, or public library.

STATEMENT—VI

This statement is intended to bring out the facilities of Trade, Commerce, Industry and Banking available in the two towns. The information pertains to 1969. The statement indicates the names of three most important commodities imported, exported and manufactured in either town, besides furnishing information on the number of banks and credit co-operative societies functioning there.

While setting priorities for inclusion of commodities in the statement, preference has been given to such commodities as have a direct bearing on the reputational importance of the town. However, in cases where these commodities whether imported, exported or manufactured have no direct link with the reputation of the town, the selection has been made on the basis of money value or quantity involved in transaction.

As also borne out by the statement, both towns continue to be steeped in stagnation and industrial backwardness. The reasons are not far to seek. They are both far flung border towns with practically little potential for development.

The main items of consumption are imported into the towns. The exports made from Rajauri town consist of pomegranate seeds (anardana), and viola serpens (bunafsha). Desi or locally prepared ghee is another commodity which is exported from these towns. The two towns have nothing to boast of by way of manufacture.

Banking Facilities :

The banking facilities in the two towns are provided by 3 banks, of which 2 are functioning in Rajauri town and one in Nowshehra. On the basis of information available for 1969

there are no societies for co-operative credit in either town.

STATEMENT—VII

This statement provides information about the distribution of population of each town of the district by religion. The data incorporated in the statement is based on 1971 Census. The statement discloses that both the towns of the district are multi-religious. The position of each religious group is reflected in the following table :—

It will be seen that Hindus constitute the predominant religious group claiming a proportion of 76.35%. Muslims with a proportion of 17.20% rank next, followed by Sikhs, with a proportion of 6.30%. Other religious groups viz., Buddhists and Christians form a microscopic proportion, together making as little as 0.15% of the total urban population.

In Nowshehra town the proportion of Muslims is even lower than that of Sikhs.

Sex ratio is adverse to females in the case of all communities in either town of the district. It is far adverse for Muslims in Nowshehra town, with only 584 females per 1,000 males.

Explanatory note on Village Directory Data Content :

As already mentioned, the Village Directory alongwith the Town Directory forms Part—A of the publication. It gives details of the amenities available in each village in such fields as area; education, medicine, power supply, drinking water, communications, post and telegraph facilities, land use pattern, distance of the village from the nearest town, day or days of market/hat and places of religious, historical and archaeological importance.

The Directory carries the following Appendices:

Appendix—I : It gives the tehsil-wise list of villages arranged alphabetically alongwith their 1971 Census location code numbers. Appearing in the beginning of the publication this appendix would help the reader to quickly identify the amenities of the village of his interest and get an idea there.

Appendix—II : It gives an abstract of the amenities available at the tehsil level. It is available after the Village Directory.

To add to the interest of the publication, it has been enriched with the following maps:—

District Map : It depicts tehsil boundaries and location of towns within. This map appears as a frontis piece.

Tehsil Map : It gives the location and boundaries of each village and town within the tehsil and illustrates with suitable symbols the population and other amenities available in each village and town of the tehsil.

Abbreviations :

To economise on space a number of abbreviations have been used in the Directory to highlight the various amenities without distorting presentation. These are interpreted below:—

The Rural Area :

The rural part of the district consists of 382 villages, of which 368 are inhabited and 14 uninhabited. It is significant to note that on the basis of number of villages, Rajaouri district ranks third lowest among all the districts of the State, the first and second lowest being Punch and Ladakh districts respectively. The rural part of the district is administered by three tehsils, viz, Budhal, Nowshehra and Rajaouri, of which the former is of recent origin, having been carved out from Rajaouri tehsil. On the basis of number of villages, Rajaouri, the district headquarter, is the biggest tehsil of the district. Budhal with only 34 villages within its jurisdiction is the smallest tehsil of the district. Nowshehra and Rajaouri tehsils respectively contain 11 and 3 uninhabited villages while there is no such village in Budhal. This is highlighted in the following table:—

It will be seen that largest number of villages, 98 or 25.65% of the total have areas ranging between 501 to 1,000 acres. Only 14 villages fall in the lowest range of less than 50 or 50 to 100 acres. It is significant to note that majority of villages in the district, 104 or 27.23% of the total fall in the size groups between 2001-5000 and 5001 and more, of these 21 villages fall in the latter size-group.

Educational Facilities

By 1968-69, 267 villages or 72.55% of the total inhabited villages of the district were provided with educational institutions. Of these, 168 villages had primary schools, 77 middle schools and 22

high/higher secondary schools. The following table gives the educational institutions of different kinds available in various tehsils of the district:-

It will be seen that of the three tehsils Nowshehra is fairly better placed in the provision of primary and middle schools, Rajauri, on the other hand, ranks lowest, the proportion of primary and middle schools stands at 39.7% and 18.1% respectively. So far as higher secondary schools are concerned Nowshehra tehsil, with a proportion of 8.1% ranks on top followed by Rajauri and Budhal tehsils.

The table reveals that the distance from the nearest town has had no impact on the diffusion of educational institutions in the rural sector. Villages falling between 16 to 25 Kms. from the town are better placed in the provision of primary as well as higher secondary schools, whereas the villages, which are comparatively nearer to the town fare better in the proportion of middle school facilities.

Medical Facilities

The medical facilities in the rural sector of the district inhabited by 208,976 persons are catered to by 35 medical institutions, consisting of one Hospital, 4 Health Centres, 26 Dispensaries and 4 Family Planning Centres. This shows that there is one medical institution for every 5,971 persons. Among the tehsils, Nowshehra is better placed in the provision of medical facilities, claiming one hospital, one health centre, 9 dispensaries and 2 family planning centres. Budhal a newly created tehsil, ranks lowest, having only 2 health centres and 3 dispensaries.

The following table gives the distribution of medical facilities per 100 km².

It will be seen that the rural sector, extending to an area 2536.5 km², claims to have 35 medical institutions, as such the average number of medical institutions per 100 km² works out to 1.4. Rajauri tehsil, with a ratio of 1.7 medical institutions per 100 km² is well above this average. The other two tehsils viz. Budal and Nowshehra have returned ratios below the district average.

Electricity

It is distressing to note that upto the year 1968-69 only 2 out of 368 inhabited villages of the district had been electrified. Both belong to tehsil Rajauri.

Drinking Water Facilities

Rajauri is one of the most neglected districts in the matter of protected drinking water facilities. By 1968-69, only one village of Nowshehra tehsil out of 368 inhabited villages of the district was provided with protected drinking water facility. Budhal and Rajauri tehsils were completely devoid of this amenity. 13 villages of Nowshehra tehsil used well water. The rest of the villages used either spring or nallah/stream water for drinking purposes.

Communication

In the matter of accessibility, the district by no means enjoys an enviable position. At the end of 1968-69, 215 villages or 58.4% of the total inhabited villages of the district were connected by roads of some kind. Of these 131 villages or 35.6% were linked with Pucca roads and 84 villages or 22.8% with Kutcha roads. As many as 153 villages claiming a proportion of 41.6% of the total inhabited villages continued to be devoid of any road connection.

The following table gives the distribution of villages with different types of roads by distance from the nearest town:—

The assumption that nearer a town, greater is the proportion of villages with Pucca roads and conversely less is the proportion of villages with Kutcha roads, does not hold good in so far as pucca roads are concerned. We see that proportion of villages provided with pucca roads is the

largest in respect of villages falling 26 to 50 Kms. away from the town. Even the villages lying farthest from the town are better placed in the provision of Pucca roads. So far as villages with Kutcha roads are concerned, their proportion increases with increase in distance from the nearest town.

Post and Telegraph Facilities

By the end of the year 1968-69 only 48 villages or 13.04% of the total inhabited villages of the district were provided with post office facilities. Budhal tehsil is the least equipped with these facilities, only 3 of its villages having post offices. It deserves to be mentioned here that the entire rural part of the district is devoid of telegraph as well as telephone facilities.

The following table highlights the distribution of post offices per 100 km².

It will be seen that Rajauri and Nowshehra tehsils are more or less at par in the number of post offices per 100 km², the corresponding ratios stand at 2.17 and 2.01 respectively. In the case of Budhal tehsil, however, there are only 0.79 post offices per 100 km².

Staple Food

Maize constitutes the main staple food and rice the co-staple food for most of the villages of the district. Among the individual tehsils, the position is somewhat different. In Budhal and Rajauri tehsils, rice forms the staple & wheat the co-staple food. In Nowshehra, however, staple and co-staple food are maize and wheat. This is reflected in the following table:—

Land Use

The land use statistics, presented in the Handbooks as part of the village directory, give in respect of each village of the district, the particulars of Forest area; Cultivated land sub-divided into (a) Irrigated and (b) Un-irrigated; Cultivable Waste and Area not available for cultivation.

The available information reveals that, the total village paper area of the district stands at 6,26,777 acres or 2536.5 km², of which the forest area, constituting 2,57,661 acres or 41.11% of the total area claims the lions share. The cultivated land, on the other hand, accounts for 1,20,076 acres or 19.16% of which only 11,235 acres or 9.36% are irrigated by different sources, the rest, more than 90% of the total cultivated land, is still at the mercy of rains. The quantitative picture in respect of other categories is as follows:—

1. Cultivable Waste=94,326 acres or 15.05%
2. Area not available for cultivation=1,44,432 acres or 23.04%

It may be pointed out here that the landuse particulars of the district as shown above are short by 2 villages, covering an area of 10,282 acres, as the requisite classification relating to these villages was not available with the concerned authorities.

In the following table attempt has been made to bring out the percentage of cultivable waste per village to average cultivated land per village by distance group from the nearest town:—

Normally the proportion of culturable waste to average cultivated land should increase with increase in distance from the nearest town. But this hypothesis is not adequately substantiated in the case of Rajauri district. As can be seen from the table the proportion of culturable waste

is higher in the case of villages at a distance of 5 kms or less than in the villages falling in subsequent distance ranges. The proportion is the least in the case of villages which are farthest from the town.
