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## PREFACE

The population count of 1981 Census started on 9th February and was concluded on the 28th Feb., with a revisional round from 1st March to 5th 2h. The Houseless Population was counted on the of February and the sunrise of 1st March was ted as the reference date.

Soon after the completion of the population t the provisional population totals were released he 23rd March with the publication of Paper I of -Provisional Population Totals of Meghalaya. In Provisional Population totals the population with Male-Female break-up, literacy with the malele breakup, decennial population growth rate, ity of population, sex ratio up to the district l and for Shillong Urban Agglomeration were prod. These were compiled from the Charge Abstract itted by the Charge Officers. Thereafter, the of data collected through the Household Schedule Individual Slips were edited and certain preliy informations were generated. These were reld in the form of a Supplement to Paper I of 1981 sional Population Totals on 5th November, 1982. e Supplement to Paper I many more informations provided like decadal variation, growth rate, atio and density of population tuto the C.D. and town level, literacy and percentage to total ation, proportion of main workers, marginal

workers and non-workers to total population and classification of workers, male and female into cultivators, agricultural labourers, household industry and other workers. Particular focus was laid on the rural and urban position of the population of the State indicating the population of each town and Shillong Urban Agglomeration. In the second part of the Supplement to Paper I - Primary Census Abstracts Part I and Part II up to the District/C.D.Block and town level were also presented. In the Appendices, the disabled population by the type of disabilities was also incorporated.

The Census Operations practically consists of two operations, viz., field operations where a large number of people are engaged for collection of vital informations who canvass the questionnaires in the houselisting, household schedules and individual slips. The second part, relates to tabulation of the data from the houselist/household schedules and individual slips. The tabulation of data again is divided into two parts, like manual tabulation and computer tabulation. In the manual tabulation, the H–II Tables relating  $\mathsf{tr}$  disabled population from the houselist and the Primary Census Abstracts upto the village level is generated from the household schedule and Individual slips. To facilitate manual tabulation of the required data within a specific time periud, the State was provided with a Regional

Tabulation Office and 44 tabulators, 7 checkers, 2 supervisors were appointed for the purpose. The magnitude of the operations for generation of basic information upto the village level from the mass of data collected from the field operations can hardly be over-emphasized and this naturally took some time. However, it was to our credit that the Primary Census Abstract was completed on the 28th Feb. 1982 according to schedule, in record time.

Based on the data generated in the P.C.A the Part II-A, General Population Tables, Part VII-Houses and Disabled Population and Part XIII- District Census Handbook A & B containing the Town and Village Directory and Primary Census Abstract upto the Village level for every District is brought out. For Meghalaya, the manuscripts of Administration Report on Enumeration, Part II - General Population Tables, Part VII Houses and Disabled Population, Part XIII District Census Handbooks are ready. However, in the absence of adequate printing facilities in the State, it may take some time to bring out the printed volumes.

In the meantime, demands for final population data has been mounting from all quarters. In order to meet this demand and with a view to provide basic

population data until the printed volumes are brought out, it has been decided to bring out Paper I of 1982 giving the final total population and the population of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes up to the Community Development Block and town level Though the data presented are elementary, yet it is hoped that these will meet the minimum needs of the data users.

Shri L.R.Marak, Investigator who have comoiled the data, Smti. L.Lyngdoh, Sr.Stenographer who have stencilled it and Shri Dilaram Pandey who has cyclostyled the data deserve my appreciation.
