PREFACE

The 1971 census was the first in Manipur after it was divided into five districts by a government order in November, 1969.

The census was conducted under the supervision of Shri H. Ranbir Singh, Director of Census Operations, Manipur. He was recalled by the State government before the tabulations were gone through. He continued to take interest in census work in his capacity as *ex-officio* Director of Census Operations, Manipur, until I took charge of the office in February 1976. Thus although this volume is going to press at a time when I happen to hold charge of the office, the entire credit goes to Shri Ranbir Singh for the successful completion of the work.

For each of the A-series tables and the State primary census abstract (PCA) presented in this volume, there is an explanatory note which will serve as an aid to the table. The concepts and definitions and the salient features of the tables have been discussed in the introduction. A few charts have been included in this publication to facilitate study.





PERCENTAGE OF AREA (km^2), 1971





INTRODUCTION

In this volume, Part II-A of the 1971 census report of Manipur, are presented the general population tables—A series and the State primary census abstract. Table A-I presents area, houses and population. Table A-II shows the decadal variation of population since 1901. The villages classified by population in different population size groups are shown in Table A-III. In Table A-IV are shown the towns classified by population in 1971 with variation since 1.019. The standard urban area is a new feature in the 1971 census. Table A-V gives its details. The primary census abstract gives the figures upto the district/sub-division level. In addition there are three appendices to Table A-I, one appendix to Table A-II, one to Table A-III, one appendix to Table A-IV. There is also an explanatory note to Appendix I, Appendix I List A and Alphabetical list of towns and one Appendix for Table A-V. An explanatory note has been added as Fly-leaf to each table to explain further details.

2. Changes in Area

From 1901 onward there had been no change in the area of the state being 8,628 sq. miles. Prior to November 1969, Manipur was a single district territory. In 1969 the state had only 10 sub-divisions. They were (1) Imphal West, (2) Imphal East, (3) Bishenpur, (4) Thoubal, (5) Mao & Sadar Hills, (6) Tamenglong, (7) Jiribam, (8) Churachandpur, (9) Tengnoupal and (10) Ukhru. According to the district re-organisation of the state in 1969, under the Manipur government order 20/39/69-D, dated 12 November, 1969, the former sub-divisions have been regrouped into 25 sub-divisions and the entire territory has been divided into five districts as under :—

The erstwhile sub-divisions of Mao & Sadar Hills, Tamenglong and Ukhru have been upgraded as North district, West district and East district respectively. The Central district has been formed of the former sub-divisions of Imphal West, Imphal East, Bishenpur, Thoubal, Tengnoupal and the villages lying at the plain area of Jiribam sub-division. Churachandpur sub-division and 15 hill villages of Jiribam sub-division have formed the South district. These 15 hill villages of Jiribam sub-division have been transferred to Tipaimukh sub-division of the South district under Manipur government orders.

A tabular statement hereunder gives a detailed picture of the constituent sub-divisions of each district.

3. Change in number of towns

In 1961 Imphal municipality was the only town in Manipur. There has been no change in the area of this town. This town has been upgraded to the status of a city in 1971 as the criterion for treating a town as city i.e. "a town which has a population of one lakh and over should be treated as a city" has been fulfilled.

In the 1971 census seven more towns have been added. Seven sub-divisional marketing centres have been declared as small towns. Government orders declaring the following small towns are given below :—

4. Changes in number of villages

In the words of Shri R.K. Birendra Singh, M.C.S., former Superintendent of census operations—"It appears that there has been no authoritative definition of a village. There is however one definition by convention; it is a mauza or area declared as a village at the time of settlement or by any competent authority. The most striking features of a village have been its stability in spite of rapid changes in the towns and the dependence of its people on agriculture as their means of livelihood". In the plain sub-divisions of the Central district, revenue villages are taken into account, but in the hill sub-divisions areas declared as village at the time of settlement is treated as a census village. Many villages which existed in 1961 have disappeared and many new villages have sprung up in 1971. There are 1949 inhabited and 44 uninhabited villages in 1971 as compared to 1866 inhabited and 42 uninhabited in 1961.

Among the 1949 inhabited villages, there are 8 villages with population of 5,000 or more in 1971 as against 2 only in 1961. These villages are found situated in the central district which seems to have the greater facilities of human habitation.

5. Literacy

As per the 1971 census, a person who can both read and write with understanding in any language has been taken as literate. A person who can merely read but cannot write is not treated a literate. Of the total population of 10,72,753 in Manipur, 32.91 p.c. is literate. If the children of age group 0-4 are excluded, the effective literacy rate comes to 38.47 p.c. The rate in the urban areas is 61.31 p.c. which is almost double of that in the rural areas which is 34.94 p.c.

6. House and households

A "census house" is a building or part of a building having a separate main entrance from the road or common yard or stair-case etc., used or recognised as a separate unit. It may be inhabited or vacant. It may be used for a residential or non-residential purpose or both. In the 1971 census 487 persons are found to be "houseless" i.e. without any house. The number was only 21 in the 1961 census.

A household is a group of persons who commonly live together and would take their meals from a common kitchen unless the exigencies of work prevented any of them from doing so.

Total households in this state is 182,593 with average size of household as 6 members. The size of household in the urban area is 6.3, a bit higher than in rural area being 5.8.

7. Workers and Non-workers

A "worker" is a person whose main activity is participation in any economically productive work by his physical and mental activity. Work involves not only actual work but effective supervision and direction of work. Workers by different categories of workers and non-workers are furnished hereunder.

8. Standard Urban area

The essential features of a SUA are (i) it should have a core town normally with a minimum population size of 50,000, (ii) the contiguous areas made up of other urban as well as rural administrative units should have close mutual socio-economic links with the core town and (iii) the probability is that this entire area will get fully urbanised within a period of two and three decades.

There is only one standard urban area in Manipur-Imphal SUA. It contains the area of Imphal municipality and 85 surrounding villages.

A-I AREA, HOUSES AND POPULATION

Fly-leaf

Table A-I is the basic population table. It relates to areas, population and houses, villages, towns, number of occupied residential houses, households and population with its break-up. This table has been presented in two parts i.e. Union and State. While the Union Table presents the data for the State and districts, the State table furnishes the figures for the sub-divisions and towns in each district.

The districts and sub-divisions in this table have been arranged in order of their location codes allotted for census purposes. In preparing the location code numbers, the district codes numbers were allotted starting from the northern part of the State and proceeded anti-clockwise arriving at the eastern portion of the State as (1) Manipur North, (2) Manipur West, (3) Manipur South, (4) Manipur Central and (5) Manipur East. In the State table the district figures are presented followed by the constituent sub-division and towns of the district concerned. Table A-I is supplemented by three Appendix Tables which furnish additional data.

This table which corresponds to Table A-IV of 1951 and 1961 censuses, gives the variation in urban population separated by males and females, decade variation and percentage decade variation for each town during the last seventy years. The status and area figures are, however, confined to 1951, 1961 and 1971 censuses only.

The towns have been arranged in order of population size and are divided into six groups as follows :

Class IV	10,000 to 19,999
Class V	5,000 to 9,999
Class VI	Less than 5,000

Imphal was the only town in Manipur till 1961 and it was all along treated as class II town except in 1951. In 1951 the area of Imphal was reduced to only 5.18 km², resulting to a considerable reduction in the total population of the town and it became a class VI town. In 1971 census, however, Imphal acquired the status of class I town.

In 1971, the concept of urban agglomeration with a stricter and more uniform definition was introduced in place of the town group concept of 1961 census. An urban agglomeration was formed by taking into account a continuous urban spread constituting a town and its adjoining urban out-growths, or two or more physically contiguous towns together with continuous well recognised urban out-growths if any, of such towns. This kind of urban growth has not been experienced in this state.

This table has been supplemented by an appendix. This appendix shows the new towns added in 1971 with area and population of each town. This appendix is further supplemented by a small table namely 'List A' which shows the towns having less than 5,000 persons.

An Explanatory Note to Appendix furnishes information on constituent villages of the new towns with population of each village in 1961 census. An alphabetical list of towns indicating the class/serial no. of each town follows these tables.

This table is presented in two parts. The first part is the Union Primary Census Abstract which furnishes information upto district level whereas the second part i.e. the State Primary Census Abstract gives similar information down to the Sub-division/Town level.

The Tables furnish area in square Kms., number of occupied residential houses, households, total population by each sex, population of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes. The table further furnishes the number of literate and educated persons, the working population classified into 9 broad industrial categories and non-workers as a separate category.

The Primary Census Abstract summarises the important demographic information and is the basis for subsequent detailed Census tabulation.
