PREFACE

This paper deals with the distribution of household population by religion of head of household down to tehsil/town level. At the 1981 Census, a question on religion was included both in the Individual Slip and the Household Schedule. The difference was that in the Individual Slip, religion was recorded for every person as returned by him, whereas in the Household Schedule the religion returned by the head of the household alone was recorded. The figures of religion for 1981 presented in this paper are based on the Household Schedule and essentially, therefore, represent the household population classified by the religion of the head of household except institutional households, in respect of which the religion returned by each inmate of the institution in the Individual Slip has been taken into account. The reader would do well to bear this in mind while making a comparison with the 1971 religion data which is based on the Individual Slip returns.

I am grateful to Shri P. Padmanabha, I.A.S., ex-Registrar General & Census Commissioner for India, Shri V.S. Verma, I.A.S., present Registrar General & Census Commissioner for India, and Shri V.P. Pandey Joint, Registrar General, India for their valuable guidance in the preparation of this volume. My thanks are due to Dr. N.G. Nag, Deputy Registrar General and his colleagues in the Social Studies Division who did the important work of scrutiny of names of the religions returned. I am also thankful to Shri N. Rama Rao, Assistant Registrar General and Shri Madan Singh, Senior Research Officer for scrutiny of the data and its uniform presentation. The inset tables and notes have been prepared by Shri Ganesh Dass, Assistant Director of Registrar General of India.

The household schedules of this Union Territory were canvassed during the 1981 Census Operations by this Directorate and were sent to the Delhi Census Directorate for processing. Shri S.S.S. Jaiswal, Deputy Director, Delhi Census Directorate, and his staff members processed the data after including the information sent by us for the institutional population and prepared the main table HH-15—Household population by religion of head of household. I am thankful to them for preparing the table.

Shri P. Lalnithanga, I.A.S., Director of Census Operations, Mizoram under whose direction the census operations of 1981 were carried out has now been transferred. I gratefully acknowledge his over-all guidance and supervision in collection of this valuable data.

INTRODUCTORY NOTE

Religion is an important and perhaps the basic cultural characteristic of the population. In a secular state like India several religions have thrived and every decennial census provides an interesting picture of the religious persuasions of the people. The data on religion yielded by the census are of great interest to the public as well as to the scholars. At the census enumeration a variety of answers might have been provided to the Questions on religion, some spurious and some merely sects to a major religion. A census enumerator had instructions to record the religion as actually returned by a respondent.

In the 1981 Census, question on religion was included in the individual slip filled in for every person and the Household Schedule filled in for a household. In question No. 8 of the Individual slip, the religion of the person enumerated was recorded, as returned. In question No. 2 of part I of the Household Schedule, the religion of the head of the household as returned was filled in.

A household is defined for the purpose of census as a group of persons who commonly live together and would take their meals from a common kitchen unless the exigencies of work prevented any of them from doing so. There could be a household of persons related by blood or a household of unrelated persons or a mix of both. Examples of unrelated households are boarding houses, messes, hostels, residential hotels, rescue homes, jails, hrams, etc. These are called institutional households. In the case of institutional households the information on religion of the head of the household was not collected in the Household Schedule. However, the informaton on religion of each inmate of the institutional household was collected in the Individual slip filled in by the enumerator for every person in the Institutional household.

The head of the household for census purposes is the person on whom the chief responsibility for the maintenance of the household falls.

In the present paper the data on main religious communities as returned in question 2 of the Household schedule of the 1981 census are being made available. In respect of the inmates of the institutional households, however, the data have been abstracted from the relevant Individual slips as the Household Schedule does not provide data on religion in respect of the institutional households. In the present paper the data on religion are presented for the Union Territory of Mizoram, its districts, C.D. Blocks and Towns.

Thus the data presented in this paper are based on (1) information on the religion of the head of the household in respect of normal households and the households of houseless population i.e. all households barring institutional households (2) information on the religion of each individual returned for question 8 of the Individual Slip in respect of individuals in the institutional Households.

The instructions to enumerators for filling up question 2 on religion of the head of the household in the Household schedule are given below :—

“You have to record the religion of the head of the household as given by him against this question. While writing the religion, you have to write the abbreviations as follows on the line against this question and not in any dotted boxes provided at the end of the dotted line against this question :

For Buddhists—write B
For Christians—write C
For Hindus—write H
For Jains—write J
For Muslims—write M
For Sikhs—write S

For ‘Others’ record actual religion as returned fully. If a person says that he has no religion, it may be recorded accordingly. If a person refuses to state his religion you may write ‘religion not stated’. You should not enter into any argument with the household for filling up this question. You are bound to record faithfully whatever religion is returned by the head of the household. For institutional households, put ‘X’ against this question.”

For the convenience of the reader Statement I showing the growth of six major religions, 'other religions and persuasions' and 'religion not stated' during 1971-81 is given at Union Territory and district level on the following statement. After this, Statement II Household Population in States/Union Territories by religion of head of household is given just to acquaint the reader with an over-all position of the six major religions in each State/Union Territory of India according to the 1981 Census.

It may be pointed out that the 1971 religion data was based on individual return as recorded in the Individual slip, whereas this paper is based on the religion of the head of the household as given in the Household Schedule 1981 Census. This point should be borne in mind while comparing the data.

NOTE ON TABLE HH-15

This table corresponds to table C-VII—Religion of 1961 and 1971. The only difference is that the figures for religion for 1961 and 1971 are based on the religion of the individual whereas the figures presented in this table give the household population classified by religion of the head of households in respect of all households except institutional households. In the case of institutional households, the information on the religion of each individual was abstracted from the Individual slip. This table is followed by two appendices and an annexure.

The table gives data for persons, males and females separately for each of the six major religious communities viz., Buddhists, Christians, Hindus, Jains, Muslims and Sikhs by total, rural and urban areas for the Union Territory/Districts/C.D. Block/Town. The number of households are also given. The religions in the table have been arranged in alphabetical order and the data

presented include all population—those living in normal households and institutional households and the houseless population.

The figures of other religions have been grouped together in the column ‘other religions and persuasions’. Details of other religions and persuasions, the strength of which at the Union Territory level is 100 and above each, appear in Appendix ‘A’ accompanying the table. In the case of each of the remaining faiths the strength of which is less than 100 at Union Territory level, their details are given for the Union Territory and Districts in Appendix-B. The Appendix C/D gives the data of those urban agglomerations which are spread over within two or more Districts/C.D. Block. This has not been prepared for this Union Territory as there is no such case in this Union Territory. The annexure which follows the Appendix-B table gives the details of sects, beliefs or religions, clubbed with another religion which is shown at the head of the table in block letters.
