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INTRODUCTION

The 1981 Census was conducted in Gujarat between 9th February 1981 to 5th March 1981. The Provisional Population figures of Gujarat for 1981 Census were released through Paper I of 1981 Census on 23rd March 1981. This paper mainly presented the sex wise total population of the State, growth rate, density of population, decadal variations in population since 1901 onwards and percentage of literacy in the State. The paper was presented to the Chief Minister Gujarat, Shri Madhavsinh Solanki on 23rd March 1981 who paid rich compliments to the organisation for the speedy publication of these provisional figures.

2. In this second paper titled "Supplement to Paper I 1981 Census", some further statistics are presented about the Rural/Urban composition of the state, Towns and Cities by size of population classification of workers and proportion of workers and non-workers to total population by sex as well as the Provisional Primary Census Abstract for the State as well as for the districts. The figures of Physically Handicapped persons as collected during Houselisting Enumeration have also been presented in this paper for the first time after 1931 Census.

3. So far as Provisional figures are concerned the present publication will be the final Census Publication for 1981 Census. The Household Schedules and Individual Slips filled up during the 1981 Census are already under process of Editing and Tabulation in the six Regional Offices in the State and further Census Publications will come out in series by about the Mid year 1982. The Census data this time will also be processed on the Electronic Direct Data Entry System which has been put up specially for processing Census work at Ahmadabad.

4. On this occasion I take this opportunity of expressing my deep gratitude to Shri P. Padmanabha, Registrar General and Census Commissioner of India for his constant inspirations and guidance in these massive operations. The 1981 Census would not have been so smooth an operation but for the

support I always got from the State Government and also from the Collectors of the districts and Commissioners of the four Municipal Corporations. The Administrative machinery at the District/Taluka level during the Census Operations was under great stress because of the District/Taluka Panchayat Elections and also because of the difficult Law and Order situation in the State due to Medical Students agitation against reservations in Post-graduate Medical Courses.

5. In particular I am thankful to Shri H. K. L. Kapoor, Chief Secretary to Government of Gujarat, for his kind support and for his full faith in me for this work. I also thank Shri R. Ramamoorthy and Shri V. Krishnamurthy, both Special Secretaries to Government of Gujarat in General Administration Department who were always helpful in conducting these operations at various stages by issuing Government orders promptly. Shri G. S. Shah, Director, Bureau of Economics and Statistics, Gujarat, was also helpful and I had almost all his men, materials and other resources at my command for this work. I thank him and all his subordinate staff including Joint Director Shri S. C. Mehta and other officers who gave me valuable support in the training operations at various stages.

6. I also extend my thanks to all the Resident Deputy Collectors (District Census Officers), District Statistical Officers (Additional District Census Officers), Mamlabdars and Chief Officers of the Municipalities (Charge Officers), District/Taluka Census staff and to a large number of Enumerators and Supervisors but for whose kind cooperation the 1981 Census would not have been a success. The Director of Printing and Stationery, Government of Gujarat and all the press Managers have promptly executed all printing orders, for which I convey my thanks to them. Lastly I thank all the officers and staff members in the Directorate of Census for their unstinted co-operation in this gigantic work.



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

1901-81




GUJARAT DISTRICT WISE URBANISATION 1981





URBAN POPULATION BY SIZE-CLASS OF TOWN**


POPULATION 1981





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**ANALYSIS
OF THE
RESULTS**

The provisional population figures of 1981 Census for the State of Gujarat have been released through Paper No. I. The data which was presented earlier at the level of the districts and big cities with more than 1 lakh population is now available at the lower levels of other cities and towns and now provisional information about the rural/urban composition and work participation rates at the State and district levels is also available. It is now proposed to supplement in this paper the statistical information already released earlier. The data presented here are also provisional and later on will be subject to variation as a result of the regular process of editing and tabulation now in progress.

This supplement paper No. I deals with mainly (1) Rural and Urban composition of the total population, (2) population and growth rate of cities/urban agglomerations and towns, (3) urban population by size class of towns, (4) workers and their percentage to total population, (5) distribution of working population by cultivators, agricultural labourers, etc., (6) provisional PCA Part I and II and (7) Districtwise figures of handicapped persons as enumerated during the houselisting stage.

1. RURAL AND URBAN COMPOSITION OF POPULATION

Table 1 shows Urban population of different States / Union Territories in India as per 1981 Census.

Table 2 shows the Rural/Urban Compositions of the State as well as the districtwise position in Gujarat State. The rural/urban break-up of the population of Gujarat State is as under :-

The percentage of urban population to the total population as per 1981 Census in Gujarat works out to 31.08 per cent as against 28.08 per cent in 1971 Census. This marks an increase of 3 per cent rise in urban population during the last decade. As regards the decennial growth rate of urban population during the last decade 1971-81 the same was 41.00 per cent as compared to 43.14 per cent during the previous decade 1961-71.

Gujarat is one of the leading urbanised States in India. This can be clearly seen from the Table 1

which gives figures of urban population in the different States and Union Territories of India based on 1981 provisional figures worked out by the Registrar General, India, New Delhi. Maharashtra with urban population of 35.03 per cent ranks first amongst the total States followed by Tamil Nadu with 32.98 per cent and Gujarat with 31.08 per cent. Thus, Gujarat ranks third in urbanisation in the total States of India. In 1971 also Gujarat ranked third in urbanisation.

The Expert Committee on Population Projection appointed by the Planning Commission and headed by the Registrar General of India, New Delhi, has worked out the projected percentage of urban population to total population of Gujarat State, for the years 1981 and 1986. According to the figures worked out by this Expert Committee the urbanisation in the Gujarat in 1981 was supposed to be 30.02 per cent and that in 1986 31.07 per cent. Thus the projection worked out for 1986 has already been achieved in 1981 which shows the rapid urbanisation in the State.

Districtwise Analysis of Rural/Urban compositions

Amongst the districts, Ahmadabad district has the highest urban population of 71.54 per cent. This is mainly due to Ahmadabad City. Out of the total population of Ahmadabad district of 3,840,472 persons, 2,515,195, i.e., 65.49 per cent are in Ahmadabad City. The district has a total urban population of 2,747,587 persons. On an all India basis Ahmadabad city is the seventh city amongst the total cities of India, the first six being Calcutta, Greater Bombay, Delhi, Madras, Bangalore and Hyderabad. The second highest urban percentage of 42.74 per cent is recorded in Surat district very closely followed by Rajkot district, where the percentage is 41.91 per cent. Banas Kantha, Sabar Kantha and Panch Mahals are the three districts with lowest percentage of urban population in the State whereas the Dangs is the only district which has no urban population.

On examining the figures of proportion of urban population to the total population as recorded during the 1971 Census, it is found that the district of Ahmadabad ranked first, Rajkot district ranked second and Surat district ranked third in 1971 Census. Thus Surat district has stolen a march over Rajkot district during the 1981 Census. Similarly the districts of Banas Kantha and Sabar Kantha have also

interchanged their ranks during the 1981 Census so far as percentage of urban population to total population is concerned. The percentages of urban population also reveal that a maximum increase of 9.66 per cent during the last decade is recorded in Gandhinagar district very closely followed by Surat district where the increase is 9.01 per cent. The lowest increase of 0.18 per cent is recorded in Kheda district. The districts of Amreli and Kachchh have also recorded an increase of less than 1 per cent. The proportion of urban population between the two censuses has decreased in the backward districts of Banas Kantha and Panch Mahals.

Decennial Growth Rates

Gandhinagar district has recorded an urban growth rate of 158.78 per cent which is mainly due to the special development of Gandhinagar town, the Capital of the State Government. The next highest urban growth rate of 76.67 per cent is noticed in Surat district followed by Vadodara district with 57.29 per cent. The lowest urban growth rate of 20.27 per cent is found in Banas Kantha district. It is also seen that in Sabar Kantha district the percentage of urban population to total population is only 9.89 per cent but the urban growth rate of 42.50 per cent is recorded in this district which is a very sharp rise. This is due to the very rapid expansion of a few urban centres of this district, namely, Himatnagar, Khedbrahma, Modasa, etc.

2. POPULATION AND GROWTH RATES OF CITIES/URBAN AGGLOMERATIONS AND TOWNS

The following criteria were adopted for treating a place as "Urban" during 1981 Census.

(1) All places where there is a Municipal Corporation or a Municipality or Notified Area or a Cantonment Board;

(2) The remaining places were determined as 'urban areas' only if the following conditions were fulfilled :—

(a) The estimated population at 1981 Census should be at least 5000 persons;

(b) The density of population per Kilometre should not be below 400;

(c) 75 per cent of the male working population should follow non-agriculture pursuits.

Before the 1981 Census Operations had commenced, an exercise was undertaken in the Census Directorate and all the Rural and Urban units of 1971 Census were examined in great details for seeing whether any of the areas classified as 'urban' in 1971 required to be declassified during 1981 Census if the above mentioned characteristics are not fulfilled in any case and whether any 'rural' areas of 1971 Census were to be classified as 'Urban' in 1981 Census because of the growth and developments during the decade. The Office of the Registrar General, India, New Delhi, also examined these proposals carefully and approved the same for 1981 Census. As a result of this exercise, the following decisions were taken :

(1) The following 7 towns included as 'Urban' areas in 1971 Census were declassified and treated as 'Rural' because the above criteria of 'Urban' areas were not fulfilled.

(2) The following 48 villages which were 'Rural' in 1971 have been classified as 'Urban' in 1981 Census because all the above criteria of classification as 'Urban' were fulfilled.

For the 1981 Census a total list of 255 urban areas in the State has been finalised in consultation with the Registrar General, India, New Delhi and the State Government. During 1971 Census such number of urban areas was 216 whereas during 1961 Census the same was 181. 255 urban areas have been classified into six classes based on population size. These are as follows :—

Note.—The towns included in the urban agglomerations have been shown in the size class of their parent urban agglomerations.

The number of Class I and Class II towns in the State have respectively increased from 8 to 13 and 17 to 23 between the two last Censuses.

Table 3 gives the details of the population as per the 1981 Census and growth rates of the cities/urban agglomerations and towns during last two decades. It will be seen from Cols. 7 and 8 of this table that the growth rate of urban population of all classes during the period 1971-81 is 40.82 per cent. The growth rate during 1961-71 was 41 per cent while the growth rate during 1951-61 was only 20.97 per cent. Thus, the urban growth rates during the last two Censuses are more or less equal.

Growth rates of different classes of Cities/Urban Agglomerations and towns

Amongst the Class I Cities/Urban Agglomerations there are 11 cities with urban agglomerations and 2 cities without any urban agglomerations. Some of the towns which are the constituents of the city urban agglomerations are also included in Class I irrespective of their size of population. There are in all 31 towns included in this category which have a population of less than 1 lakh but have been treated in Class I because they are the agglomerations of the core city. Such towns in Ahmadabad Agglomeration are (1) Sardarnagar (M), (2) Sahijpur Bogha (M), (3) Naroda NP, (4) Naroda INA, (5) Hansol VP, (6) Ahmadabad Cantonment, (7) Odhav NP, (8) Odhav INA (9) Nikol VP, (10) Ranip VP, (11) Vejalpur VP, (12) Vastrapur VP, (13) Memnagar VP, (14) Ghatlodia VP, (15) Ghodasar VP, (16) Isanpur VP, (17) Kali VP, (18) Vatva INA. In Surat Urban Agglomeration such towns are (1) Udhna NP, (2) Karanj VP, (3) Nana Varachha VP, (4) Umra VP, (5) Limbayat VP, (6) Bhedvad VP and (7) Bhettan VP. In Vadodara Agglomeration there is only one town of Tarsali included in this Agglomeration. In Jamnagar Urban Agglomeration (1) Bedi and (2) Navagam Ghed VP. In Porbandar Urban Agglomeration Chhaya VP, in Wadhwan Urban Agglomeration Surendranagar (M), in Navsari Urban Agglomeration Jalalpor VP and Vijalpur VP and in Patan Urban Agglomeration Veraval (M) are the respective towns included in the Class I size.

Amongst the 13 Class I cities/Urban Agglomerations the highest growth rate is recorded in Surat urban agglomeration at 85.10 per cent followed by Vadodara urban agglomeration with 59.16 per cent.

During 1971 Census Surat Urban Agglomeration and Vadodara Urban Agglomeration had the highest growth rates of 55.27 per cent and 50.94 per cent respectively. This shows the faster development of Surat city as compared to Vadodara city.

It will not be out of place if some of the developments which have taken place during the last decade around the cities of Ahmadabad and Surat are taken special note of. In case of Ahmadabad agglomeration while the total decadal growth rate of Ahmadabad Municipal Corporation areas is only 26.07 per cent, the growth rates of towns, namely, Vejalpur, Vastrapur, Memnagar, Ghatlodia, Ghodasar and Isanpur are 472.78 per cent, 312.92 per cent 238.45 per cent, 1392.80 per cent, 262.04 per cent, and 334.37 per cent respectively. All these areas were rural areas with round about 5000 population during 1971 Census but during the last decade have grown to sizeable developing towns near Ahmadabad. The lower incidence of house-taxation in the Panchayat areas of these towns as compared to the house-taxation within the Ahmadabad Municipal Corporation limits availability of open agricultural lands in these areas and also proximity to Ahmadabad city, etc., have led to large scale building construction activity in these areas within the last ten years. Similarly in case of Surat urban agglomeration also the growth rates of (1) Udhna, (2) Karanj and (3) Limbayat which are 257.91 per cent, 2128 per cent and 1350 per cent are worth mentioning. Here also while Karanj was a small rural village of 1636 population in 1971 the same has grown to a big town of population 36450 during 1981. In case of Limbayat the same was a small rural village of 1914 population in 1971 but has now in 1981 grown to a slum-town of population 27749 near Surat city. Udhna near Surat city is growing because of large industrial establishments in the city.

Amongst the 23 Class II towns the highest growth rate is recorded in Gandhinagar township because of the large scale building activities both by Government and private owners. Gandhinagar is the Capital of the State Government and seems to be gradually stabilising and growing to a large town and its development into a city within the next decade perhaps will be much faster after the new Sachivalaya Complex and Assembly buildings are occupied. The other towns where growth rates are worth mentioning are Anand (41.69 per cent), Mahesana (41.23 per cent) Jetpur (49.77 per cent), Gandhidham (58.10 per cent),

Palanpur (45.54 per cent), Amreli (42.38 per cent), Upleta (55.47 per cent), and Botad (56.20 per cent). The lowest growth rate in this class is found in case of Khambhat (10.39. per cent).

Among 46 Class III towns in the State Himatnagar in Sabar Kantha district has recorded the highest growth rate of 67.05 per cent followed by Keshod town of Junagadh district 63.37 per cent. The other towns where growth rates are appreciable are Deesa 46.91 per cent, Ankleshwar 45.58 per cent, Modasa 42.26 per cent, Bardoli 45.55 per cent and Manavadar 41.55 per cent.

Among the 76 Class IV towns in the State Songadh in Surat district has recorded the highest growth rate of 69.73 per cent followed by Khedbrahma a tribal town of Sabar Kantha 66.41 per cent, The other towns where growth rates are appreciable. are Talala (62.56 per cent), Vapi (41.27 per cent) Thangadh (53.67 per cent), Gariachar (42.65 per cent) Talaja (46.91 per cent), Jafrabad (50.68 per cent), Tharad (56.69 per cent), Adityana (45.21 per cent), and Rapar (45.86 per cent). Out of these, Vapi and Thangadh are growing industrial towns whereas Jafrabad is now growing because of the installation of a new Cement Plant by Narmada Cement Co. Adityana is a prominent quarry town.

Amongst the 9 Class VI towns there are seven towns treated as 'Urban' for the first time in 1981 Census and hence these have no appreciable growth rates. Out of the 9 towns 6 are industrially notified areas notified after 1971.

3. URBAN POPULATION OF SIZE CLASS OF TOWNS

Table 4 gives the details of population by size/ class of towns in the State. For comparative study the proportions of population in each size class to total urban population in the State for 1971 and 1981 are reproduced from this table as under.

From the above, it will be seen that Class I towns continue to contain the maximum proportion of urban population in the State. This proportion has increased from 48.97 per cent to 57.92 per cent during 1971-81 period. The proportion of urban population in Class II towns has registered a slight fall mainly due to the fact that many of the towns which in 1971 were under Class II town category have now been classified as Class I cities. In particular Porbandar, Junagadh, Patan Veraval, Wadhwan, Bharuch and Navsari Agglomerations have moved from Class II in 1971 to Class I in 1981. The proportion of urban population in the remaining classes of towns has decreased during the decade. The maximum decrease of 3.02 per cent is noticed in Class V towns as against the minimum of 0.07 per cent recorded in Class VI towns. It may be noted that all Class I towns together contain about 58 per cent of the total urban population in the State whereas the remaining towns of all size classes contain only 42 per cent of the total urban population.

The above table also gives the growth rates of these towns in the decades 1961-71 and 1971-81. The growth rates for each class of town are shown below.

The highest growth rate in the decade 1971-81 of 156.56 per cent is registered in the Class VI towns. This is so because of inclusion of new towns which are notified industrial areas in this class. The next highest 85.28 per cent is recorded in Class V towns. The lower growth rate of Class II towns as compared to previous decade is mainly due to the towns mentioned earlier which were classified in 1981 as Class I cities and thus depleted the Class II group of a sizeable population.

The proportion of population of each city/urban agglomeration to total urban population of the State is shown in the below statement.

Among the cities in the State, Ahmadabad Agglomeration has contributed the maximum proportion of urban population of 23.83 per cent. Out of 13 places classified as cities Ahmadabad continues to have a predominant position. Surat and Vadodara Agglomerations contribute more than 15 per cent of the urban population to total urban population of the State. The remaining 10 Agglomerations/Cities together, contribute only about 18 per cent to total urban population of Gujarat.

Urban Sex Ratio

Table 4 also shows the Sex Ratio of different size classes of the cities/urban Agglomerations and Towns. The highest sex ratio of 943 females per 1000 males is recorded in Class IV towns. The lowest sex ratio of 842 is in Class VI towns. The average sex ratio of 884 is recorded in Class I towns. Among 13 class I cities/Agglomerations the highest sex ratio of 949 is recorded in Porbandar Agglomeration. The lowest sex ratio of 853 is in Navsari Agglomeration. The sex ratio of 860, 869 and 890 are recorded in Surat, Ahmadabad and Vadodara

Agglomerations respectively. All these three cities are important developing industrial areas and males apparently migrate to these cities in large numbers for seeking work from rural areas.

The average sex ratio in Class II town is recorded as 930 females per 1000 males. Among the 23 towns included in this size class, in Dhoraji Municipality females outnumbered males, viz. the highest sex ratio of 1015 is found in this town. The next highest sex ratio of 983 is noticed in Sidhpur Municipality closely followed by Dahod Municipality with 981. The lowest sex ratio of 862 is found in Gandhinagar town closely followed by Dhrangadhra Municipality with 866.

4. and 5. WORKERS AND THEIR PERCENTAGE TO TOTAL POPULATION AND DISTRIBUTION OF WORKING POPULATION BY CULTIVATORS, AGRICULTURAL LABOURERS, ETC.

In the 1981 Census, it was decided to collect information regarding the economic activity of the people in great details. The economic questions consisted of the following four parts:—

I Q.14-A—Worked any time at all last year ?

II Q. 14-B—If yes in 14-A did you work for major part of the last year ?

III Q.15-A—Main activity last year ?

Q.15-B—14-B—Yes—Any other work any time last year ?

14-B—No—Work done any time last year ?
(C/AL/HHI/OW)

IV Q.16—If No in 14-A or 14B seeking/available for work ?

Yes (1) / No (2)

The above questions were canvassed for every person irrespective of age or sex. These questions were meant to get details of the work done by the people with reference to last one year before the date of enumeration.

Definition of work

In 1981 Census work has been defined as participation in any economically productive activity. Such a participation may be physical or mental in nature. Work involves not only actual work but also effective supervision and direction of work.

Reference period

In all the questions, the reference period was one year preceding the date of enumeration. Certain types of work such as agriculture, household industry, etc., are carried on either throughout the year or only during certain seasons or parts of the year depending on the local circumstances. In such cases what we were concerned with is the broad time span of the agricultural seasons preceding the enumeration.

Through Q.14A it was possible to find out the number of all workers which included full-time workers, part-time workers, marginal workers and even workers

whose contribution was otherwise quite insignificant and also the total number of non-workers.

The Q.15B was meant to elicit information on the secondary or marginal work which a person might have done any time at all during the last one year apart from the main work or other activity. It was expected that full-time workers may have done some other work or a person who was essentially a non-worker, though one has not done any work over the major part of the last year might also have done some work occasionally. Thus these questions gave us details of secondary and marginal work in respect of both workers and those who were mainly non-workers.

Based on Tables 5 and 6 printed in this booklet the following statement shows the percentage of main workers to total population and percentages of workers "in "cultivators," "Agricultural Labourers" "Household Industry" and "Other workers" to total workers recorded during 1971 and 1981 Census.

Before we analyse the provisional data relating to workers and non-workers as obtained from the provisional figure of 1981 Census, it will be worthwhile to recapitulate the concept of "Workers" and "Non-workers" adopted during 1961 and 1971 Censuses also. At the 1961 Census there was no attempt to collect information regarding secondary work. At the 1971 Census a specific inquiry was made regarding secondary work and the information relating to workers and non-workers with secondary work was collected. At the 1981 Census the information relates to main workers and marginal workers and these categories are exclusive. The total population of 1981 Census will thus consist of main workers, marginal workers and non-workers.

The total number of persons classified as 'Main Workers' during the 1981 Census comes to 11,004,183 which in terms of percentage comes to 32.40 per cent to total population for the State. This percentage was 31.45 per cent during 1971 Census showing a little increase over previous Census.

Amongst the 19 districts of the State the highest percentage of 39.84 per cent is recorded in Surat district very closely followed by the Dangs district with 39.66 per cent. The lowest percentage of workers is recorded in Gandhinagar district with only 29.21 per cent closely followed by Mahesana, Junagadh and Ahmadabad districts with 29.75 per cent 29.76 per cent and 29.84 per cent respectively. During the 1971 Census the highest percentage of 41.82 per cent was recorded in the Dangs district and the next highest of 37.19 per cent was also found in Surat district. Thus both these districts have exchanged their position in 1981 so far as the percentages of workers to total population are concerned.

On comparing the percentages of workers to total population as obtained in 1981 Census with 1971 Census, it is seen that in districts Junagadh, Kachchh, Banas Kantha, Gandhinagar, Panchmahals and The Dangs, the percentage have decreased which varies from 0.47 per cent in Junagadh to 2.85 per cent in Panch Mahals district. In all the remaining 13 districts an increasing trend is noticed during the last decade. The maximum increase of 2.65 per cent is recorded in Surat district followed by Bharuch district with 2.05 per cent. The lowest increase of 0.49 per cent is noticed in Ahmadabad district followed by Valsad district with 0.75 per cent.

As will be seen from Table 5 the average percentage of male workers to total population is 51.77 per cent,

whereas this percentage in respect of females is only 11.85 per cent. The respective percentages recorded during 1971 Census were 51.24 per cent and 10.26 percent. The highest percentage of male workers is also recorded in Surat district with 57.49 per cent followed also by The Dangs district with 56.05 per cent. The lowest percentage of 47.51 per cent is found in Gandhinagar district. It is interesting to note that The Dangs district has the highest percentage of 22.80 per cent in respect of female workers followed by Surat district with 20.77 per cent. Banas Kantha district has the lowest percentage of 7.18 per cent females workers closely followed by Kheda district with 8.11 per cent and Ahmadabad district with 8.14 per cent.

The 'Workers' have been further classified as Cultivators, Agricultural Labourers, workers in Household Industry and Other workers.

The 'Workers' constitute 32.40 per cent of the population in the State while marginal workers and 'non-workers' constitute 7.84 per cent and 60.26 per cent respectively. As per Table 6 it is seen that the 'Cultivators' constitute 37.76 per cent of the total workers and 'Agricultural Labourers' and 'Workers in Household Industry' constitute 22.82 per cent and 2.71 per cent respectively and 'Other workers' constitute 36.71 per cent of the total workers. The percentage of Cultivators recorded during 1971 Census was 43.12 per cent showing a decrease of 5.36 per cent in the 1981 Census whereas in respect of Agricultural Labourers and workers in Household Industry there is no significant change between the two Censuses. There is a rise of 5.14 per cent in the category of 'other workers' between the two Censuses which is a sizeable increase as compared to the increase in other categories of workers.

Amongst all the districts the highest percentage of 72.42 per cent in respect of "Cultivators" is recorded in Panch Mahals district as against the lowest percentage of 12.15 per cent recorded in Ahmedabad district. A similar phenomenon was noticed during 1971 Census also. Out of 19 districts only 4 districts, viz., Panch Mahals, The Dangs, Banas Kantha and Sabar Kantha have recorded more than 50 per cent under this category.

With regard to 'Agricultural Labourers' Bharuch District has the highest percentage of 41.29 per cent. It is followed by Vadodara district with 31.04 per cent and Surat district with 28.31 per cent. Panch Mahals district has the smallest percentage of persons (11.25 per cent)

working as 'Agricultural Labourers' followed by Jamnagar district with 13.20 per cent.

With regard to workers in "Household Industry" Surendranagar district has the highest percentage of 4.57 per cent in this category followed by Bhavnagar with 3.63 per cent and Ahmadabad with 3.49 per cent. The district with the smallest proportion of its population working in 'Household Industry' is Panch Mahals with 1.52 per cent only, which is closely, followed by Vadodara district with 1.73 per cent.

With regard to 'Other Workers' Ahmadabad has the highest percentage in this category (69.86 per cent) followed by Gandhinagar with 49.36 per cent. The lowest percentage of 14.81 per cent is recorded in Panch Mahals district followed by The Dangs district with 16.86 per cent. The highest proportion of 67.92 per cent was also recorded in Ahmadabad district during the 1971 Census. However, the next highest of 39.53 per cent was claimed by the Rajkot district during the 1971 Census.

With regard to Sexwise percentages recorded during the 1981 Census in different categories of workers it will be seen that in the category of male "Cultivators" the highest percentage of 74.04 per cent is recorded in Panch Mahals district as against the lowest male percentage of 12.80 per cent recorded in Ahmadabad District.

With regard to the category Males "Agricultural Labourers" the highest percentage of 33.72 per cent is found in Bharuch district and the lowest of 7.76 per cent is recorded in Panch Mahals district.

As regards males in the "Household Industry" the highest per centage is claimed by Surendranagar district with 4.27 per cent as against the lowest of 1.49 per cent found in Panch Mahals district. With regard to the males in 'Other Workers' the maximum proportion is recorded in Ahmadabad district (73.45 per cent) and the lowest of 16.71 per cent is claimed by Panch Mahals district.

Regarding the female work participation rates the following observations are made.

Under the category of female 'Cultivators', the maximum percentage of 65.38 per cent is claimed by Panch Mahals district and the lowest of 6.38 per cent by Gandhinagar district. Regarding the category of female 'Agricultural Labourers' the highest percentage of 67.26 per cent is noticed in Vadodara district as against the lowest of 25.21 per cent found in The Dangs district. As regards the category of females in 'Household Industry' the highest percentage of 6.44 per cent is recorded in Ahmadabad district and the lowest of 1.54 per cent is found in Vadodara district. Under the category of 'Other Workers' the maximum percentage of 45.54 per cent has been claimed by Ahmadabad district as against the lowest of 6.58 per cent by Panch Mahals district.

Marginal Workers

The statement given below shows the percentages of Main Workers and Marginal Workers to total population of rural/urban.

The percentages of Marginal workers in total rural and urban areas of the State are 7.34 per cent, 6.58 per cent and 9.00 per cent respectively.

The highest percentage of Marginal workers to total population is claimed by Ahmadabad district with 23.42 per cent. The next highest of 10.59 per cent is recorded in The Dangs district followed by Panch Mahals with 9.30 per cent and Valsad district with 7.04 per cent. Surat district has the lowest percentage (2.72 per cent) followed by Gandhinagar district with 2.91 per cent and Bhavnagar district with 2.99 per cent.

The highest percentage of marginal workers in rural areas is found in Mahesana district with 11.07 per cent closely followed by The Dangs district with 10.59 per cent. Next in order comes Panch Mahals district with 10.39 per cent and Valsad district with 8.69 per cent. The lowest percentage of 3.67 per cent is recorded in Gandhinagar district. Next in order comes Bhavnagar district with 4.23 per cent, Ahmadabad district with 4.33 per cent and Surat district with 4.38 per cent.

In respect of urban areas Ahmadabad district has the highest percentage of marginal workers with

31.01 per cent, followed by Mahesana district with 5.39 per cent, Rajkot district with 3.10 per cent. It is worthy of note that in all other districts except Ahmadabad the percentage recorded in urban areas are very low as compared to rural parts of the districts. This seems to be due to the fact that people living in urban areas have a tendency to hide their secondary work or the enumerators are not able to extract the information regarding such type of marginal work of persons by asking probing questions during the field inquiry. However, before drawing any definite conclusions it needs detailed investigation.

6. PRIMARY CENSUS ABSTRACTS PART I AND II (PROVISIONAL)

Based on the provisional population totals Primary Census Abstracts have been prepared in two parts, namely, Part I and II as shown after Table 6 of this paper. These are absolutely provisional figures. While Part I presents Total Population, Density of Population in Sq. Kms., females per 1000 males, percentage growth of population during 1971-81 and literate population with their percentage to total population, the other Part II shows the

figures of total main workers, their percentage to total population, categorywise main workers classified into 'Cultivators', 'Agricultural Labourers', 'Household Industry', 'Other Workers', Marginal workers and non-workers. These figures in both these parts are presented first for the State as a whole and then districtwise for all the districts of the State. Separate figures have also been shown for Class I cities and their Urban Agglomerations in each district. These figures are self-explanatory and need no further comments.

7. PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED PERSONS :

Table 7 gives the districtwise figures of the totally handicapped persons in the State. During 1981 Census at the houselisting stage in June 1980 a special count was undertaken for the totally Blind, totally Crippled and totally Dumb persons. In Gujarat State in all 68,399 physically handicapped persons have been enumerated out of which 23,442 are totally blind, 32,386 totally crippled and 12,571 totally dumb.
