## WHERE AND HOW PEOPLE LIVE - AN OVERVIEW OF QUALITY OF LIFE

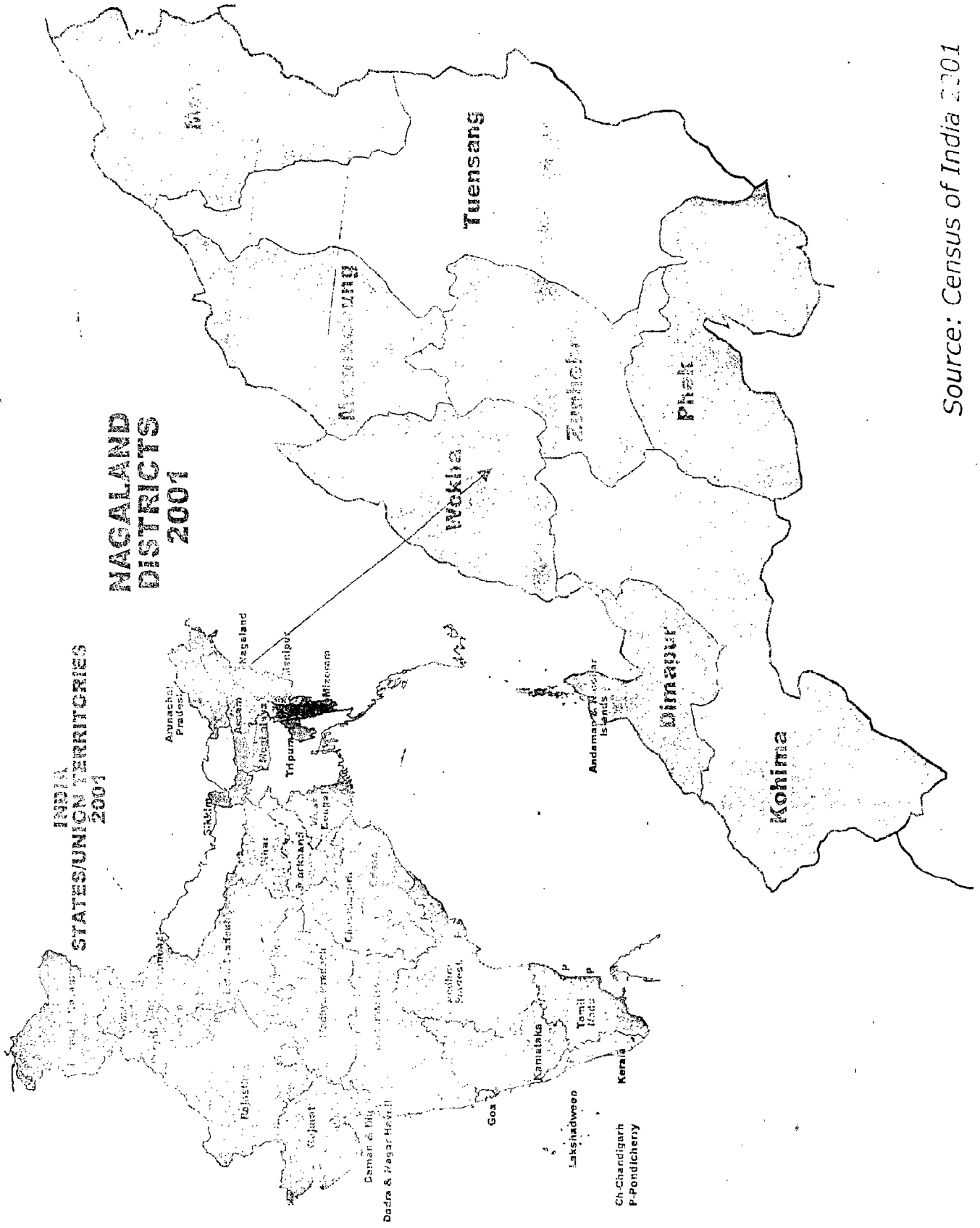
In Nagaland state the House-numbering and Houselisting operations were carried out between the 16th May 2000 & 15th June 2000 during which all structures, houses and households were listed. This was done so as to prepare a well knit frame for conducting the population enumeration during February - March 2001 without omission or duplication of any area throughout the state. During the houselisting operations wide range of data on housing, amenities and assets available to the household were collected. This data will bring out the quality of life the people of Nagaland are living. The data produced by this collection will be an important tool for the planners at the state and national level. In addition, this data will be quite useful for the administrators at lower level such as district, circle (sub-district) and town/village. The private entrepreneurs and other market related organizations will also find this data handy for their purposes. Research institutions will be supported by this data.

The present volume gives a summary of the tables on housing, household amenities and assets at the state level for quick reference for the total, rural and urban areas separately. A few charts/diagrams have been added to help the date users in assessing the situation in one glimpse at state level.

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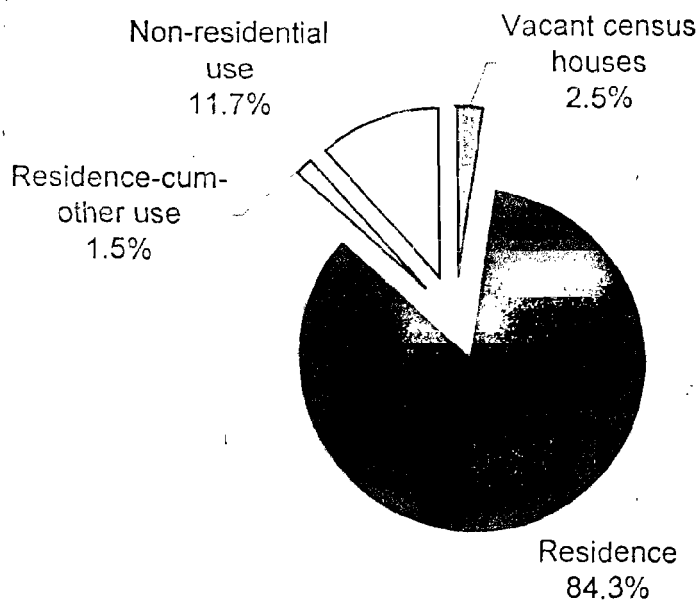

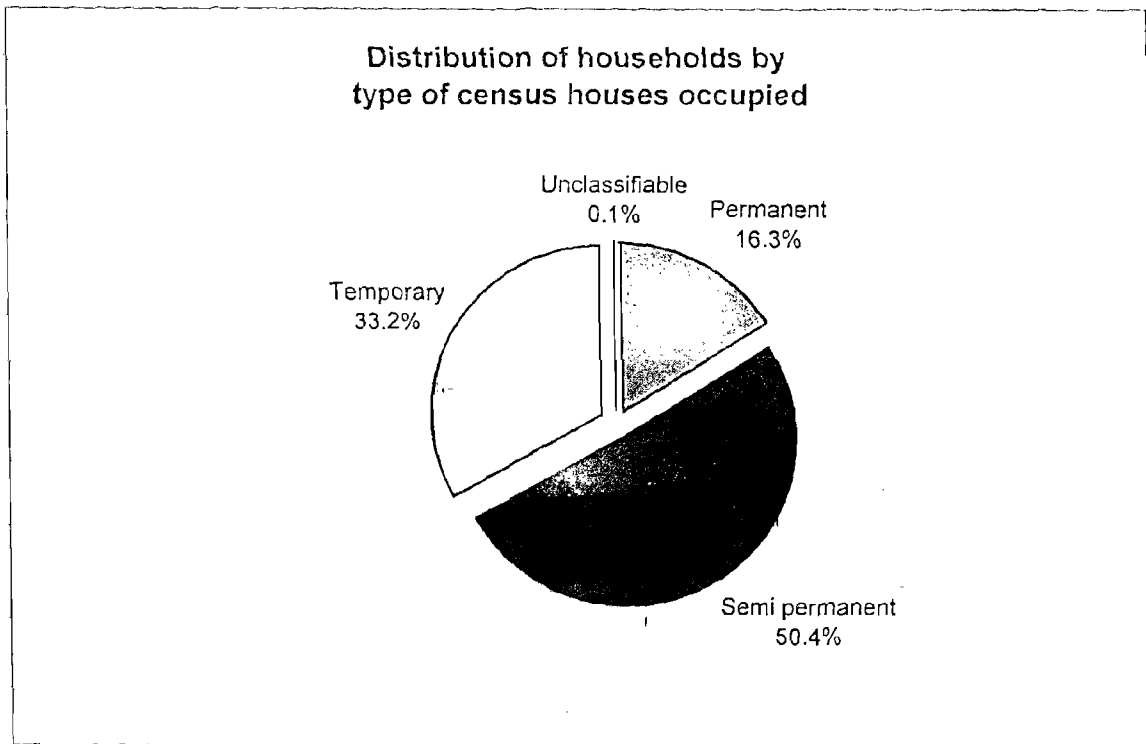
