G.S.R. 405.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of Constitution and in supersession of the Office of the Registrar General, India and ex-officio Census Commissioner for India, the Language Division of the Office of the Registrar General, India, and the offices of the Directors of Census Operations in States and Union territories [Senior Technical Assistant (Printing)] Recruitment rules 1987, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the said post of Senior Technical Assistant (Printing) in the office of the Registrar General India as well as all the offices of the Directors of Census Operations in the States and the Union Territories, namely:—

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Office of the Registrar General, India and ex-officio Census Commissioner for India and the offices of the Directors of Census Operations in States and the Union territories [Senior Technical Assistant (Printing)] Recruitment Rules, 2001.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay.—The number of the said post, their classification and the scales of pay attached thereto, shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit, other qualifications etc.—The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto, shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualifications—No person, -

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage, with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts ;

Provided that the Central Government may if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax—where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
