G.S.R. 239.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, and in supersession of the Office of the Registrar General, India and ex-officio Census Commissioner for India (Deputy Director) Recruitment Rules, 1982, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Deputy Director in the office of the Registrar General, India, namely :—

1. **Short title and commencement.**—(1) These rules may be called the Office of the Registrar General, India (Deputy Director) Recruitment Rules, 2005.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Number of posts, classification and scales of pay.**—The number of the said post, its classification and the scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed hereto.

3. **Method of recruitment, age limit, other qualifications, etc.**—The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (14) of the said Schedule.

4. **Disqualification.**—No person,—

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person, having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts :

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. **Power to relax.**—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. **Saving.**—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes, ex-serviceman and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Deputation

- Deputation : Officers under the Central Government ;**
- (a) (i) holding analogous posts on regular basis in the parent cadre or Department; or
- (ii) with five years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in posts in the scale of pay of Rs. 8,000—13,500 or equivalent in the parent cadre or Department; or
- (iii) with eight years' service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in posts in the scale of pay of Rs. 6,500—10,500 or equivalent in the parent cadre or Department; and
- (b) possessing the following educational qualifications and experience :
- (i) Bachelor's degree from a recognised university or equivalent.
- (ii) five years' experience in administration, establishment and accounts matters and having undergone training in organisation methods and work study from Institute of Secretariat Training and Management or any other recognised Institution.

(Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation or department shall ordinarily not exceed three years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.)
