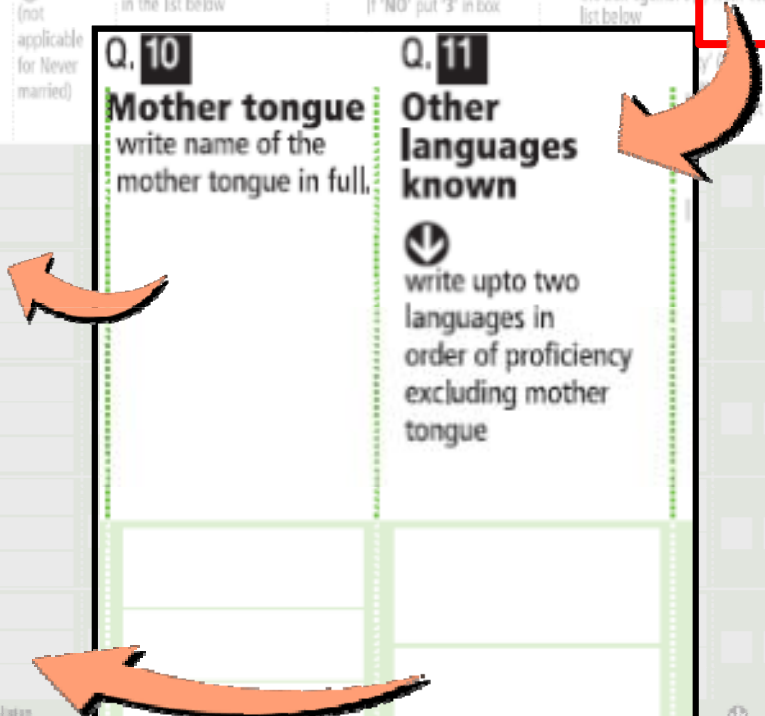

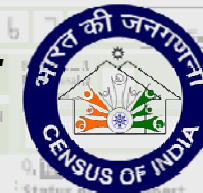

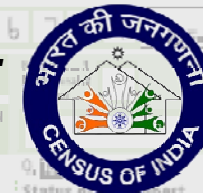
Q.10 Mother Tongue:

- For infants and deaf mutes
 - Language spoken by mother should be recorded
- Write the name of mother tongue in full exactly as returned by respondent
- Religion and mother tongue names are not related

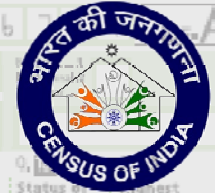

Filling up of the Household Schedule *Definition- Mother Tongue:*

- Language spoken in Childhood by the person's mother to the person
 - If mother died in infancy, language mainly spoken in the person's home in childhood
- In case of doubt, language mainly spoken at home

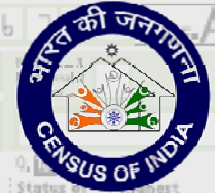

Definition- Mother Tongue...

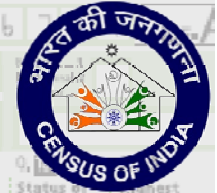
- Mother tongue need not have a script
 - Bhili/ Bhilodi, Gondi (MP)
 - Monpa, Adi, Galong (Arunachal Pradesh)
 - Paite, Zou (Manipur)
 - Zemi (Nagaland)

Filling up of the Household Schedule *Definition- Mother Tongue...*

- Mother tongue may have script of another language:
 - Liangmei (Nagaland), Lusai / Mizo (Mizoram):
Roman script
 - Santali, Mundari, Ho, Kharia
 - West Bengal: Bengali script
 - Bihar/ Jharkhand – Hindi script
 - Odisha – Oriya script
 - Tulu (Karnataka): Kannada script
 - Badaga (Tamil Nadu): Kannada script

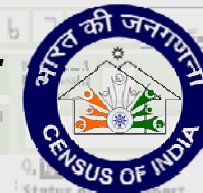

Filling up of the Household Schedule

Definition- Other Languages Known (Q.11):

- Exclude Mother tongue
 - Hindi, Bhojpuri, Rajasthani, Chhattisgarhi are not different languages
- Write name of up to 2 languages known in order of proficiency

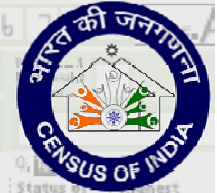

Definition- Other Languages Known (Q.11):

- Proficiency means conversation skill (speak and understand other's speech)
 - One may not read or write in that language
- Other language can be Indian or foreign
 - English is not a foreign language



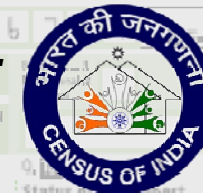

Remember:

- Do not dispute with the respondent
- You are not expected to decide if language returned by a person is a dialect of another language



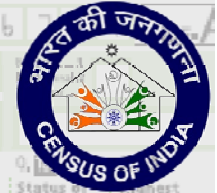

Remember:

- If you suspect any organised movement at your area regarding the return, record as per the version of the respondent and report to your Supervisor

Remember:

- A household may have related or unrelated members
- It is absolutely essential to ask mother tongue for each person
- Mother tongue may be different for different persons in same household
